PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

I. PURPOSE

It shall be the goal of the Youth Art Show of the *Coastal Carolina Fair* to provide increased awareness of the artistic talents of the youth of the coastal area by promoting the exhibition of art and to make available the opportunity to participate in the show.

II. ELIGIBILITY

1. School children between the ages of 6 and 18 years who are residents of Berkeley, Charleston, Dorchester Counties and surrounding areas who are presently enrolled in elementary, middle, or high school. If older than age 18 years, the artist must have completed the work while in school within the past twelve (12) months. A limited number of entry packets are available at the fair office for homeschool students who would like to submit work. **Due to limited space we are not able, at this time, to accept work from private studios.**
2. Each eligible school in the area receives a limited number of registration tickets. It is the responsibility of the art teacher at each school to make the professional decision as to which pieces of artwork will receive a ticket and thus be submitted for entry into the Fair.
3. No artwork will be accepted without the registration ticket. (*Attached to lower right corner*)

III. ENTRY RULES

1. **PHOTOGRAPHS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR THIS SHOW.** Mixed-media artworks containing photography elements will be accepted, but works that are only photography must be submitted to the fair's Photography Show, under that show's rules, which vary from the rules and entry dates of the Youth Art Show. The Youth Art Show cannot and will not transfer these entries to the Photography Show.
2. All entries must have a border or matting as specified by the enclosed illustration.
3. No student may enter more than one work of art.
4. Artworks must not have been previously exhibited at the Fair.
5. The artist, by entering the show, stipulates the work is completely original and not a copy of any published photographs or works of art by another artist.
6. The Fair Committee reserves the right not to show any picture it considers unsuitable, due to size or subject matter. Acceptance at the time of entry will not guarantee that the work will be exhibited. Youth Art pieces are not for sale, as this is an amateur showing.
7. All entries must be delivered to the **Exchange Hall Building (NEW LOCATION – see attached map)** at the Exchange Park in Ladson, on **Sunday, October 24, 2021** during the hours of **1:00 p.m. - 3:00 p.m.** Late entries will not be accepted by the business office. All work must be picked up 15 days later between **3:00 - 6:00 p.m.** on **Monday, November 8, 2021.** Any unclaimed items remaining after that time are subject to disposal at the discretion of the Fair Committee.
8. The *Coastal Carolina Fair* and management will not be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur to any work of art.
9. Entry forms are not available on the website. The art instructors at each of these facilities receives a limited number of registration tickets, and it is at their discretion to choose which pieces of artwork will be submitted to the Fair.
10. The *Coastal Carolina Fair* and management reserves the right to use photos of any submitted artwork on its website and promotional materials, at its sole discretion.

VI. ART SHOW AWARDS

1. **Placement Awards:** In each of the six age groups, the Youth Art Show Judge may select up to six (6) art works to be awarded ribbons for first place winners, six (6) art works for second place, and six (6) art works for third place.
2. **Judge's Award:** Six art works from each age group may be selected by the judge to be deserving of a special award. The award will consist of a \$35.00 check and a rosette.
3. **Best In Show Award:** One award will be given in recognition of outstanding artistic talent. This award will consist of a \$75.00 check and a rosette.

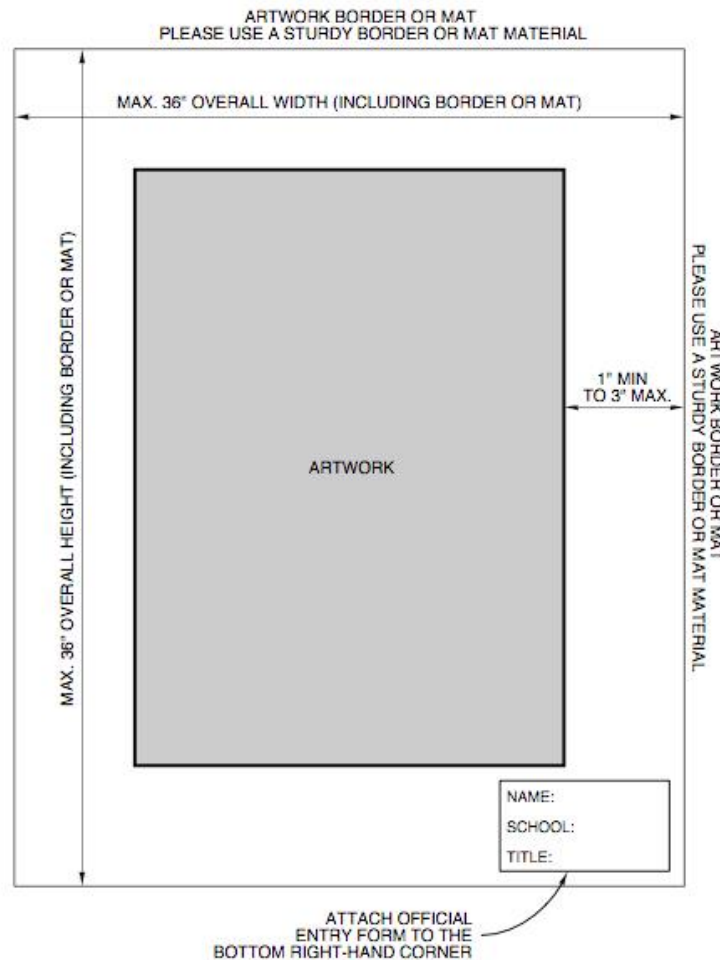
THE EXCHANGE CLUB OF CHARLESTON AWARDS

In addition to the artwork selected by the panel of judges, four awards will be chosen by a member(s) of the Exchange Club of Charleston. These pieces will be displayed prominently in the Youth Art Show, and will receive a rosette. Each artist will also be presented with a \$50.00 check.

THE JUDGE'S DECISION WILL BE FINAL IN ALL CASES

ENTRY NOTE: *Strict adherence to all entry rules is required. Failure to comply may disqualify the entry.*

ARTWORK REQUIREMENTS



Although not required, we strongly recommend that teachers take photos of all student artwork prior to submission to help with the pickup process.
