

2023 Photography Display Guidelines

Due to a variety of unforeseen circumstances, the Photography Competition has been suspended for 2023. However, if you would still like to submit photos for display, with no judging or prizes, you can submit them to the Creative Arts Division on **Saturday, October 21st, from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm** and **Sunday, October 22nd from 12:00 to 4:00 pm**.

Photo pickup will be on **Monday, November 6th between 1:00 and 7:00 pm**.

We welcome both Color and Monochrome (Black & White) photos.

- All photo entries should be a minimum print size of 8" x 10". Maximum outside dimensions including mat is 16" x 20". The maximum thickness is 1/2 inch.
- While a mat is not required, all photo entries must be mounted on a firm backing. The backing must cover the entire back of the submission. We may not accept submissions in which a photograph is taped to a mat or construction paper. Do not attach your photo to the backing using photo album corners. For the best presentation we recommend that your photo be mounted using foam core or gator board.
- It is highly recommended photographs be mounted with an adhesive other than transparent tape. We cannot accept entries with exposed areas of adhesive; they cause damage to other photos.
- No framed pictures or pictures with a glass or plastic covering will be allowed in the contest. No photographs with hooks or similar hanging devices will be allowed.
- The exhibitor's name, address, telephone number, and title of the photo should be listed on back top left corner of the photo entry and on the entry tag.
- Please limit your submissions to four (4) photos.
- The Fair Committee reserves the right to refuse to show any photo it considers unsuitable.
- Depending upon the total number of entries and available space for hanging, the Fair Committee may not be able to display all photos submitted.
- Only one photograph per mount.
- Entries must be original work of the photographer.
- No photographs of photographs or paintings.
