#### ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

1. The parade may not be used to further any cause no matter how worthy, whether it is social, religious, political or commercial. (No political entries) Seated Officials are the guests of the committee. Determination of the acceptability of any entry is the sole discretion of the committee. NO BLATANT ADVERTISING!

#### No phone number, address, or .com's

- 2. All entries must be decorated. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- 3. Loose livestock will not be permitted. NO LIVESTOCK ON THE GRASS ANYWHERE
- 4. Throwing of anything (candy, water, etc.) from any entry will not be permitted on the parade route. If the entry provides out walkers, candy, and only candy may be distributed along the parade route. Violations will result in removal from current and possibly future Stampede parades. Please see page 4
- 5. Children under the age of twelve must be on a float or vehicle. may not walk down the parade route for safety reasons. We offer a Kiddies Parade on July 2<sup>nd</sup>. Please see Kiddies entry form.
- 6. All parade participants riding on a float will remain on the float at all times while on the parade route.
- 7. To qualify for any prize, it will be necessary to enter both the 3rd and the  $4^{\rm th}$  and comply with all guidelines. You must be at your assigned number by 8:30 A.M. on the morning of the  $4^{\rm th}$  in order to receive your award. Winners will be identified by banners as they start the parade route on the  $4^{\text{th}}$ .

#### PLEASE RETURN BANNERS TO VOLUNTEERS AT THE END OF PARADE ROUTE.

- 8. It is the responsibility of each entry to attach your entry Numbers. Entry numbers must be visible to both sides of Sheridan Ave.
- 9. Maps included in entry packets explain positioning of line up. Packets will be available on July 1st 10:00 AM till 2:00 PM. at the Parade Committee Office. Please do not come to the office before the designated times as the entry committee members will not be available to assist you until the posted times.
- 10. A copy of these rules and the release agreement signed by the responsible person in charge of the entry must be in the possession of the Parade Committee on or before June 28th. (Page 4)
- 11. Any hitch team is required to provide their own outriders/out walkers this is MANDITORY, you will not participate if you do not have them. Additional help may be provided if requested.
- 12. Any group firing black powder must use light loads. Hot loads will result in entry being pulled responsible for filling out, signing and taking the extra form to the police station for approval and return a form back to the Parade Committee. If this is not done you-will not be able to shoot during the parade

  13. All winners please give prize banners to volunteers at the end of the parade

  14. All prize money must be redeemed within 90 days of being issued. Unclaimed public returned to the parade committee for the following year.

  15. The Stampede Parade Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry that does not comply and /safety Guidelines.



- CANDY DISTRIBUTION.: No parade is complete without candy for the youngsters. The Parade Committee truly appreciates the generosity and added efforts of those sharing sweets with parade spectators. The joy on faces when candy hits the street is priceless. However, to preserve the safety and enjoyment of all, candy distribution must be accomplished utilizing walkers, skaters, side by sides, bikes, pushing/pulling wagons/strollers, etc. that can travel along the white shoulder lines of the street and keep the snacks between the white shoulder line and curb as illustrated:



FOR THE SAFETY OF OUR SPECTATORS, CH|LDREN, HORSES, WAGONS, OUTRTDERS, MOUNTED ENT|RES, AND OTHER LIVESTOCK, THROWING CANDY OR ANY OTHER ARTICLES FROM ENTRIES IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN. IT IS IMPERATIVE WE MAINTAIN CLEAR MARGINS BETWEEN SPECTATORS AND PARADE ENTRANTS ON BOTH SIDES OF THE PARADE TO ALLOW EMERGENCY VEHICLE/RIDER ACCESS ALONG THE PARADE ROUTE. ARTICLES LEFT IN THE STREET DRAW SPECTATORS INTO THE STREET NEGATING EMERGENCY ACCESS CAPABILITY AND PUTS SPECTATORS, LIVESTOCK, AND EQUESTRIAN RIDERS AT RISK. YOUR COOPERATION IN THIS MATTER IS GREATLY APPRECIATED AND WILL HELP ENSURE A SAFE AND ENJOYABLE EXPEREINCE FOR ALL.
