CODY NITE RODEO GROUND RULES

General PRCA RULES APPLY:

PRCA handbook is always available on the table in the office

RODEO STARTS AT 8:00 gates open at 7:00

RODEO OFFICE opens at 7:00

EACH CONTESTANT WILL GET ONE COMPANION PASS – given to the contestant - when they ask, and AFTER their fees are paid

Must be entered that week to get a companion pass to watch

EVERYONE MUST PAY FEES BEFORE THEY COMPETE MUST be paid by 8:30pm

ENTER:

EACH Sunday NOON-1:30 we start a new week of entries, so call and get your name on the books IN ADVANCE

** OR **

Entries will also be taken each day from 11:00 to 1:00 @ (307) 527-9453

You MUST turn out by 6 pm or you will be required to pay your fees before you enter again

CONTESTANTS MAY ENTER FOR THE WEEK STARTING EVERY SUNDAY - but remember to turn out before 6 p.m. if you can't come. IF YOU ARE A "NON-NOTIFIED" TURNOUT YOUR NAME WILL BE TAKEN OFF THE BOOKS UNTIL YOU PAY YOUR TURN OUT FEES

THE DRAW WILL BE IN THE AFTERNOON - ANYONE IS WELCOME TO ATTEND WHILE WE DRAW (computer draws positions and stock)

CALL BACKS ARE BETWEEN AT 1:00 & 1:30 EVERY DAY - LISTEN TO THE RECORDING IF THERE IS NO ANSWER

EACH NIGHT IS A NEW RODEO - CONTESTANTS MAY DRAW THE SAME ANIMAL IN A ROW (excluding 2-day rodeo exceptions)

MBRC CAN LET SOMEONE EXHIBITION AT THEIR DISCRETION

MBRC HAS THE RIGHT TO TAKE LATE ENTRIES IF THE EVENT IS NOT FULL BY THE TIME THE BOOKS CLOSE

We will take 8-10 in each event during the perf (some exceptions) all entries after that will run in slack after the rodeo

WE WILL HAVE SLACK IF we have too many entries for the perf

Contractor may extend any event into a two-day rodeo based on the number of contestants and you will be asked to compete the following day

Two-day rodeo added money and points will DOUBLE

EVERY contestant MUST fill out and sign a release & W9 BEFORE competing or riding on the grounds

ENTER (be on the grounds, arena, warmup, etc.) AT YOUR OWN RISK

ENTRY FEES: \$25 for rough stock, \$35 for timed events - CASH ONLY

TIMED EVENTS:

Team roping points will be given to header and heeler

Wednesday night is Salinas Night

Header and heeler come out of the header's box

ALL TIMED EVENTS GET ONE THROW

TEAM ROPERS MUST BE 50 YRS OLD or Female TO TIE ON (no exceptions)

ANY TIMED EVENT CATTLE THAT GET OUT – THAT PERSON WILL RUN THE EXTRA

CHUTE RUN ALL TIMED EVENT CATTLE

\$10 hat fine for timed events (keep your hat on)

BREAKAWAY ROPING:

ALL FEMALES are eligible to enter and MALES 15 and under

Bell collar catch only

BREAKAWAY ROPERS MUST USE OUR STRING

PAY OUT:

\$100 ADDED TO EACH EVENT

Will pay 1 money for every PAID 5 entries
1-5 pay one money
6-10 pay two monies
11-15 pay three monies
15 and up pay four monies (max)

EVERYONE MUST HAVE PROPER DRESS CODE IN AND OUT OF THE ARENA:

Long sleeve button-up western shirt, hats, boots

MUST CLEAN STALLS DAILY

NO CUSSING OR FIT THROWING

ANYONE WHO THREATENS any employee of Mo Betta Rodeo Company or a Stampede Board Member will be BARRED for the rest of the season - NO EXCEPTIONS

IN ORDER TO GET A RE-RIDE, THE CONTESTANT MUST GIVE AN HONEST EFFORT

MBRC HAS THE RIGHT TO SUSPEND OR BAN ANYONE FROM THE CODY NITE RODEO

NO DOGS ALLOWED

ANY AND ALL COMMENTS OR COMPLAINTS NEED TO BE ADDRESSED TO MAURY OR NIKKI TATE

JR. STEER RIDING & JR. BARREL RACING: Ages 5-12 Limit (5) CONTESTANTS EACH NIGHT

PEE WEE (4 and under) May be lead-line limit 1 per nt

Only 1 parent behind chutes in jr. steer riding

Entry fees \$5 - \$5 added

JR's - IF YOU ARE 12 ON JUNE 1st YOU CAN ENTER THE REST OF THE SEASON AS A JR.
MBRC HAS THE RIGHT TO ASK FOR BIRTH CERTIFICATE

Jr. Barrel racers and Jr. Steer riders are LIMITED to entering 5 out of 7 nights. They must take two nights out of every 7 off.

JR. BULL RIDING: Ages 13-17 Entry fees \$10 - \$25 added

Which 2 nights per week to be determined

Top 5 taken to the CNR FINALS

POINTS:

Points will be given to 10 places each night -- each event

10 points for first

9 second

8 third

7 fourth

6 fifth

5 sixth

4 seventh

3 eighth

2 ninth

1 tenth

beyond that everyone gets one point

MONTHY SEREIES BUCKLES

Accumulative points for the month determine winner of event – in case of a tie it will go off money won

The contestant can only win one series buckle for each event
