

## Columbia County Fair Camping Information and Rules

Weekly camping is from July 12-19, 2026. Weekly campers will be given spaces inside the fenced camping area as long as space is available. Weekly campers are allowed to move in at any time between the 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> during camping superintendent hours.

- Dry camping only. No pets. No fires (except camp cookers) in the campground at any time.
- Vehicles without a registered parking pass will not be allowed through the parking check without paying, and 4H bracelets do not count as parking passes.
- All vehicles must stop for a parking pass check with the camping superintendent or security each time entering the campground.
- All vehicles will park in a designated parking area. Unregistered vehicles will be allowed to drop off supplies on move-in day, but will not be allowed to stay or park in the camping area. Vehicles not registered with a pass within the campground at the end of day will be removed at owner's expense.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed outside of an individual campsite. No bar set ups, kegs or alcohol banners area allowed inside the campground.
- All campers under the age of 21 require an adult (over 21) chaperone throughout their stay. Campers under 21 are not to be left unattended overnight.
- Quiet time is from 10pm each day until 7am each morning. Generators can run only in non-quiet time hours (unless given medical exception beforehand).
- Campsites remaining 48 hours after close of Fair will be removed at the owner's expense.
- Failure to comply with these rules will result in removal from the campground.
- All accommodations beyond what is listed here will need to be worked out with the camping superintendent. Contact info is listed below.
