#### **DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

• Quarter Midget Racing Association – contract

Rose-Ann Hamness, Kim Johnson, and Gene Bolante from the Association were there– Butch mentioned the conflicts and concerns with the contract. The permanent tower will be on wheels. everything will be on wheels. Butch mentioned when you dig the track down 12 inches and fill with clay, that's a permanent track They know of the five weeks black out time. They were not aware of any other time periods with regards to 4-H and the Rodeo Committee. The trailer and storage box -scale will be temporary also on wheels – fire lanes during the fair – three rows of parking and two roads fire lane – Ed mentioned the schedule will need to be

approved. - - Kim mentioned they have a 10-week racing schedule. Carol said they typically use 45 parking spots –They work with –and raise funds for community .Woody can live with sharing parking the contract would need to be amended to include the dates with 4-H and rodeo committee dates. Kim said they have been working on this for 3 years. Henry is concerned – traffic and motors and horses – dangerous – we have to make sure this works and Ed has worked on this for hours. Henry was concerned – suggest to everyone – encourage the contract with conflicts and existing operations – We either negotiate or pull the trigger. we should continue with contract. Kassie suggested to email all the board members. Butch would prefer the scale be moved. Branden mentioned you cannot have to much communication. email preferred need a point person – Kassie will respond –-- Kassie thinks everyone should be informed - Ryan – Emer. Mgmt. you can set up an email to go to all – The Racing Assoc will will be contacting us when the permit is ready – they plan on having a race in September. . - Office Report Jodi -a volunteer is coming out to help in the office wi-fi coming in June in the 4-H bldg. Eva mentioned she has seen bees and wasps -
- Treasurers Report we have a balance of 64,601.13
   Eva The grange is doing dinners during fair. will be bringing a big bar b q. Cert has been helping with traffic at night for the past two years. They are the only ones certified for traffic control. –she will work directly with Jay

Katherine Johnson – Master Gardner – They hold the annual spring event selling tomatoes–has costed 590 500 - With the new proposal it would be 1500.00 – cleaning subject – demo garden - master garden – the support us. They made about 2000.00 last year profit as expenses. Kassie – explaining what the volunteers and prices needed to be consistent – need - It was suggested for her to send in a proposal

Sheryl Savage talked about the open horse show – judges 200.00 each - - buckles costed 479.00 for 6 –would like to be reimbursed. – Kassie moved to have Sherly be reimbursed Henry 2d, motion passed.

Open ride – OSHET is requiring the girls to pay for insurance - We have a waiver for all to sign

Ryan Emer Mgmt. mentioned the Lewis and Clark bridge will be closed during the fair.
