- All awards given at the Judges' discretion. The judge will remain anonymous.

- Each entry must be titled and the entrants name/address/phone number must be written on the back ONLY. If personal information is on the front, the photograph will be disqualified.
- Entries cannot be a picture of a picture. The Exhibitor must have taken the actual picture.

Prints:

- Photography entries must be mounted (matted) on standard mount material.
- NO FRAMED PHOTOGRAPHS WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- Matt and Foam Boards must be BLACK and 2" in width. Foam Boards MUST BE CLEAN CUT!

Adults/Teens/Professional:

- Entries are to be a MINIMUM of 8 X 10 or an oval print of 9 ½ X 12", equaling 80 square inches.
- Entries can be a MAXIMUM of 16X20.

Youth/Preschool:

- Children may enter prints with a MINIMUM print size of 4 X 6 and may NOT exceed 8 X 10.

Entries NOT ALLOWED:

- Images previously entered in the Columbia County Fair and Rodeo will not be accepted.
- No TWO entries shall be of the same subject.
- Any entry that has been reproduced from an existing photograph, portrait, graphic, or any other artwork produced by another person is a violation of the Fair rules and will not be judged, accepted, or displayed. If any entry, in the good-faith opinion of the jury panel (Fair Board) violates copyright, trademark or another other applicable law, that entry shall be disqualified.

- Linen, China, Glassware, Flatware, and other accessories should be marked with the owner's name, but markings will not show when the accessories are in place.
- Reasonable precaution will be taken to ensure the safety of the exhibits by the exhibitor, the Fair Board assumes no responsibility for lost or damaged items.
- Any tableware used on an award-winning table may not be used again for 2 years.
- Limit of 1 entry per exhibitor

- Entries will be accepted only on Sunday, July 17th from 11a.m.- 3p.m. and on Monday, July 18th from 12 noon to 8p.m.
- Entries will be released after 5:30p.m on Sunday July 24, 2022.
- Entries not picked up by July 28nd will be disposed of.
- The exhibitor name must be the person who made the item. If the item is exhibited for another maker, the item will not be judged and will be “for display only”.
- Dried exhibits should be in glass jars.
- Exhibits may be disqualified if the rules are not followed.
- An entry consists of one standard jar. Use standard canning jars (no mayonnaise jars); designed for canning purposes. New ring and lid must be sued. All others will be refused.
- Entries must have been processed since the 2021 Columbia County Fair.
- Artificial flavorings, colorings, or preservatives will automatically disqualify entries. Exceptions are mint, kiwi, and maraschino.
- Canned foods are judged on flavor, color, clarity, texture, shape and pack. The pack should be neat and uniform, with whole or uniform pieces filling the jar, covered with liquid.
- The Judges may open any jar for inspection. However, if other visible characteristics of product eliminate the product from consideration of an award, the Judge is not obligated to open for further evaluation.
- Jellies should retain their natural color, be transparent and cut easily, yet hold their shape. Jam and preserves should contain pieces that are firm, with clear, thick syrup. Butters (fruit that has been pressed through a sieve) should be of a standard size.
- All jams and jellies should have a ¼” headspace.
- Freezer jams are not allowed.
- Do not put your name on canned goods.
- All products must be processed according to recognized canning methods, (i.e. Kerr, Ball, OSU Extension Service Bulletin (including jams and jellies)).
- Grange members should identify what grange they represent when filling out their entry form. Points will count towards All-Around high Point Grange Plaque.

- The display must showcase Fair Theme, **BACK IN THE SADDLE AGAIN**, in some way.
- Furthermore, the display must represent the community by way of crops, products, community activities or way of life.
- Artificial produce is highly discouraged, but if used, please follow fire codes.
- Due to growing season, products are not required to be grown by the group. However, if products start to spoil please replace them for the enjoyability of the Fair attendees.
- Granges having shown at previous Fair have priority, with spaces thereafter allocated on the basis of earliest entries received.
- Display must be a completely new design than previous years.
- No commercially labeled products will be permitted.
