ALL PARTICIPANTS 18 AND UNDER ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A HELMET

- No cross-entry in age groups/High point divisions; age as of January 1, 2022
- Novice is any horse or rider in their first year of showing or not to have won any ribbons in 3 classes in that event.
- To qualify for a Hi-Point/Reserve Champion, participants must enter in required classes for their age division, please refer to schedule page for required classes. Same horse and rider also
- Tradition show attire not required; however, boots, long pants, and long-sleeve shirts are required.
- Schooling is allowed in age-appropriate class only so long as it is not disruptive. **Not Open class or novice.** It is the discretion of the judge and show committee as to what is disruptive. If you do not qualify to be in that class you must turn your number upside down to indicate you are schooling.
- Classes may be added, combined, split, or cancelled, at the discretion of the Columbia County Open Horse Show Committee
- Ribbons to 6th place
- No stalls available
- Participants enter the Columbia County Fairgrounds property at their own risk and are subject to facility rules and regulations. Refunds only to participants who provide a note or excuse from a medical doctor/veterinarian.
