## LOCAL RULES

- Management reserves final and absolute right to interpret the following rules and regulations and to arbitrarily settle questions and differences thereto or otherwise arising out of, or connected with, or pertaining to the Junior Livestock Exposition, Grand National and exhibits. Any exhibitor who violates any state or local rules will forfeit all privileges and premiums.
- 2. All State Rules published by the California Department of Food & Agriculture, Division of Fairs & Expositions are in force for the Grand National Stock Show. Copies of the State Rules are available online at <u>www.cdfa.ca.gov/fe</u>.
- 3. Show Entries are open to all youth from ages 9 to 21 as of JANUARY 1, 2020.
- 4. Animals may not be entered in both breeding and market shows.
- 5. All entries must be made using our online entry system. Please note that for an entry to be accepted, the entry fee MUST be paid using a credit card through the online system. Any unpaid entries WILL NOT be accepted. The Grand National reserves the right to reject any entry at will. All entries must be made via our online entry system. The system will accept entries until 11:59 PM on Wednesday, September 30, 2020. NOTE: If you are having difficulties with the site or have technical questions, please e-mail dstornetta@cowpalace.com. Any entry that is not paid for by this time will be not be accepted. Late entries will not be accepted.
- 6. All Exhibitors must complete the State required YQCA Ethics Certification. To complete your entry, you must have your YQCA certification number available. You can complete the certification at <u>yqca.org</u>
- 7. <u>Refunds</u> will not be considered for amounts under \$50.00. Please see State Rule II 6 for requirements. Overpayment of entry fees will not be refunded. In the event of a major livestock disease outbreak in the United States, Cow Palace Management will determine a fair and universal system for the refund of any entry fees collected by the exposition. This system will be based on the date of the outbreak, the severity of the outbreak, and the operational costs associated with and undertaken by Cow Palace Management for the Livestock Show. Any approved refunds will be issued within 30 days of the close of the show.
- 8. <u>PROTESTS:</u> Protests will be considered only if there has been a violation of state or local rules. Judge's decision on awards CANNOT be protested. All protests must be presented to the Livestock Exposition Manager in writing within 24 hours of the alleged violation and must be accompanied by a \$500.00 cash deposit, which will be returned if the protest is deemed valid.
- 9. Management reserves the right to add, delete, combine or change classes to benefit the show. Unless otherwise noted, all classes are judged using the American System.
- 10. Premium checks will be mailed after the show. Checks will not be reissued until 30 days after they have been mailed. Checks must be cashed within 90 days of issue to remain valid. Expired checks will not be replaced. Lost checks may be subject to a \$25.00 fee.
- 11. By submitting an entry, each exhibitor and his/her parents (if under 18 years of age), hereby release rights to any photo or video taken for publicity purposes.

## VIRTUAL SHOW CLARIFICATION

- 1. Weights will be submitted by exhibitors with entries; the weight submitted needs to be as true to the date of the video as possible.
- 2. The weight posted by the exhibitor will be used to break the classes online.

### VIDEO ENTRY CREATION GUIDELINES

- 1. <u>An entry without a video submission cannot be judged or evaluated, therefore an entry</u> without a video submission is an incomplete entry and will not be allowed to add a video <u>after entries close.</u>
- 2. The video must be a minimum of 30 seconds and a maximum of 1 minute.
- 3. Cell phone videos are encouraged.
- 4. Camera should be held sideways while shooting, not vertically.
- 5. Videos should be taken outside with a background clear of visual distractions. No previous awards, banners, etc. may be in the background of the video.
- 6. No talking in the video.
- 7. All videos must include the animal's head with a clear view of the permanent id (ear notch, scrapie tag, tattoo) that is identified on the entry. These need to match show entry numbers.
- 8. Show card must be worn on exhibitors for the duration of the video and must be visible during video
- 9. The <u>video footage must consist of one continuous video</u>, which starts with a clear view <u>of the permanent id</u>. The video should then follow the pattern of the animal being judged in the ring as follows with no stops or restarts:
  - a. <u>Lambs and Goats</u> Start with the head and show the **permanent id** in the animal's ear; then begin with still standing views of the animal- start with the front view of the animal, then move to the off-side view of the animal (animal's left side), then move around to the back side of the animal including a shot of the animals topside, then move around to the show-side of the animal; walk the animal 20 steps forward with the camera capturing a view with the animal walking from the side for the first 10 steps, then allow the animal to walk away from the camera the remaining 10 steps; camera should be *approximately* 5 to 9 feet away from the animal to include both the animal and showman in the footage.
  - b. <u>Swine</u> Start with the head and show the **permanent id** in the animal's ear; hogs must be shown on the move/walking, starting with the camera on the hog's show side (animal's right side), then show the hog walking toward the camera, and then show the hog walking away from the camera, show the off-show side (hog's left side) of the hog. Include the showman in the footage approximately 5-9 feet away.
  - c. <u>Beef Cattle</u>- Start with the head and show the **permanent id** in the animal's ear; begin with still standing views of the animal- start with the front view of the animal, then move to the off-side view of the animal (animal's left side), then move around to the back side of the animal, then move around to the show-side of the animal; walk the animal 20 steps forward with the camera capturing a view with the animal walking from the side for the first 10 steps, then allow the animal to walk away from the camera the remaining 10 steps; camera should be *approximately* 12 to 15 feet away from the animal to include both the animal and showman in the footage.
- 10. Video should be on a flat surface with nothing obstructing the view of the hoof/pasterns.

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- 11. Animals must be shown by the exhibitor.
- 12. Large animals (cattle, sheep, goats, and swine) cannot be displayed in a chute, on a rack, on a fitting table, tied to the fence, etc. The animal must be *shown*.
- 13. The exhibitor's face must be clear in the video.
- 14. Fitting is encouraged just like animals would be at the show in order to allow for the clearest evaluation on the animal but **is not required.**
- 15. Exhibitor needs to be dress appropriately, just like at the show.
- 16. NO EDITING of the video. Video should be one take, with no stopping, starting, and no breaks. No audio allowed in the video. If you have sound in the video, you can take it down when uploaded into YouTube or Vimeo.
- 17. Helpful hint: Pretend the camera is the judge.
- 18. Exhibitors must wear show card in the video to verify the date of filming.
- 19. <u>This video must be taken and submitted between September 21<sup>st</sup> and September 30<sup>th</sup>,</u> 2020 and submitted no later than September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at 11:59 pm. \*\*IT IS HIGHLY <u>RECOMMENDED THAT YOU DON'T WAIT UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE SO THAT IF YOU</u> <u>HAVE TECHNICAL DIFFICULTIES YOU HAVE TIME TO REMEDY THEM.</u>
- All video submissions MUST be uploaded to YouTube or Vimeo and the link for the video submitted upon the time of entry. These must be public not private and the link must be the short format or they won't work.

## **GRAND NATIONAL LIVESTOCK EXPOSITION BEN BEAM MEMORIAL JUNIOR SHEEP SHOW**

Ben Beam was the 2016 Cow Palace Grand National Blue Ribbon Award recipient. The Blue Ribbon Award is given in appreciation to an individual or business who has volunteered their time and energy in support of the Grand National. Unfortunately, Ben passed away on November 11, 2015. His family accepted the award on his behalf.



Ben was born June 9, 1957, in Manteca, California. He attended San Joaquin Delta College and then went on to Fresno State to earn his Bachelor's degree before completing his Master's Degree at Cal Poly, San Luis Obispo. Ben taught at Denair High School before his college teaching career began at Lassen College. He instituted a rodeo and livestock judging team there, and began traveling the state and nation competing with passion and commitment. In 1994, he came back to his roots and alma mater at San Joaquin Delta College, teaching agriculture and building livestock judging teams of young and talented individuals.

As part of his program at Delta College, Ben brought a team of students to the Grand National Livestock Exposition. He served as the Sheep Superintendent and his students worked the sheep and goat shows as well as helped with whatever project needed to be done. He did this at no cost to the Cow Palace. He held a fundraiser that paid for their travel, lodging and food while they were working at the show. Ben was had a calming effect in the barn and would always find a way to solve an issue. He was a tremendous teacher and turned interactions into a learning opportunity for all involved.

In 2014, Ben's health no longer allowed him to be in the barn but he still wanted to be involved. He brought his team of students to work the show and he prepared three meals a day for the entire livestock crew.

Family was the most important thing in Ben's life. He is survived by his wife Terri, his four children Lacey, Andrew, Casey, and Shaylynn, and his daughter-in-law Chelsea. His adored granddaughter Brenyn Lynn was everything Ben ever dreamed of wrapped up in a beautiful package of vitality, expression, and blonde curls. Benjamin Davis Beam, named after his Poppy, is the newest addition to the flock. Ben, along with his family, owned and operated Beam Ranch Club Lambs. His family is committed to maintaining the same quality of lambs that Ben always strived for.

To his friends, colleagues, students, and the livestock industry, Ben represented unmatched loyalty, love, professionalism, compassion, and expertise. Ben's love of cooking, of livestock and horses, of fishing and hunting, and of knife-making and leather work, touched the corners of our country. He loved to gently guide and impart his wisdom in quiet but authoritative ways. Ben is and will continue to be the finest example of someone who will *Outlive His Life*.
