DISCLAIMER

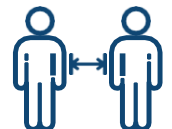
- Exhibitors and their family members acknowledge that personal protective equipment ("PPE") designed to reduce the chances of exposure to or infection with the virus may not be readily available at the fair's facilities for their participation in the livestock events.
- Exhibitors and their family members acknowledge that the Cow Palace/Grand National Jr. Livestock Show may not, and is under no legal duty to, provide any PPE to exhibitors or their family members. Exhibitors and their families should provide their PPE for participation in the Cow Palace/Grand National Jr. Livestock Show's livestock events.

PREVENTION MEASURES



- While a universal, countywide indoor masking mandate (for all indoor settings countywide) is not currently implemented by the health officer or the state, San Mateo County Health and Cow Palace Management urges all guests to wear a mask inside when not actively eating or drinking. Wearing a mask indoors reduces COVID-19 risk for individuals.
- Any exhibitor, vendor, employee, volunteer, participant, and/or guest who exhibits symptoms of virus will not be allowed into the event unless presenting proof of negative test to facility management.
- All exhibitors, their family members and other related persons participating in the livestock events shall comply with all health and safety orders, rules, and guidelines related to the Virus promulgated by the State of California, County of San Mateo, City of Daly City, and the Cow Palace/Grand National Jr. Livestock Show.

PRACTICE SOCIAL DISTANCING – WEAR A MASK



- All exhibitors, their family members, and other related persons participating in the livestock events are encouraged to wear a face mask while in a building, **including exhibiting**, wash hands frequently, use hand sanitizer or antibacterial wipes, and maintain social distancing when possible.
- Inside the buildings and around show rings, social distancing should be practiced.

COVID-19 WARNING

Exhibitors and their family members understand and acknowledge that participation in the Grand National Jr. Livestock events or use of the Cow Palace facilities may expose them to contact with one or more persons who have been infected with, and/or exposed to, the Virus.

Exhibitors and their family members further understand that participation in the Grand National Jr. Livestock events or use of the facilities may expose them to contact with surfaces or objects that contain the Virus and may serve as a means for transmission of the virus to others who participate in the livestock events or use the facilities.

Based on the foregoing, Exhibitors and their family members understand and acknowledge that participation in the Cow Palace/Grand National Jr. Livestock events and use of the facilities may expose them, along with others with whom they may come in contact after they leave the Cow Palace facilities, to a risk of infection with the Virus, which may cause significant and serious illness, temporary or permanent disability, and/or death.

- You are experiencing any flu symptoms, such as headaches, shortness of breath, runny nose, sore throat, cough, or fever.
