QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS & RULES:

- 1) All exhibitors must currently be enrolled in Coweta County 4-H.
- 2) Showmanship classes will be Pre-Club, Cloverleaf, Junior and Senior as determined by the 4-H'ers grade as of August 1, 2022. General appearance should be that of neatness and cleanliness. All exhibitors are required to wear white shirts and dark colored pants or jeans with a belt. Appropriate footwear must be worn such as boots or riding shoes, tennis shoes will be accepted. No sandals or shoes with heel straps will be accepted.
- 3) Exhibitors will be judged on their ability to handle and examine poultry, the exhibitor's knowledge of poultry, appearance and actions. Knowledge tested will be age appropriate and consist of questions related to breeds, classes and standard care and management of poultry.
- 4) All poultry must be owned or maintained by the 4-H'er.
- 5) Only one bird per child, per class may be shown.
- 6) Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal in showmanship.
- 7) All birds must be free of parasites and/or contagious disease.
- 8) ALL birds must be Pullorum Typhoid and Avian Influenza tested by State Officials. Appropriate fees will apply. Testing will be done at the Fairgrounds on Thursday, Sept. 15th and Monday, September 19th.
- 9) Any birds in the show that appear sick will be removed from the show grounds.
