### **Arrival & Mandatory Check-in: Tuesday, 8/4 from 9am-2pm**

Open Class check-in is at the Open Class Beef/Sheep barn.

All exhibitors must have breed-appropriate registration papers. Younger Youth is also required to check-in. Call Kim if arriving after 2pm.

**Release & Pen Break-Down:** Sunday morning, 8/9. NO SATURDAY LOAD-OUTS FOR OPEN CLASS.

**Show Schedule:** Friday, 8/7 following 4-H/FFA (approx. 9am\*), Open Class Show Ring \*Time may vary

**At check-in, exhibitors must have breed-appropriate registration papers and paperwork or ID that proves participation in the Scrapie Program.** All animals must be tattooed, and the tattoo must match the registration certificate:

6 months of age & older: an original certificate of registration and/or recordation

Under 6 months of age: an original certificate of registration or recordation or a stamped duplicate application showing the date received by the ADGA office.

### **Rules for Open Class Dairy Goats**

*(This year's show is not recognized by the American Dairy Goat Association as an official show.)*

- See **Livestock Rules & Regulations on pages 2-3.**
- **Entries in the goat departments will be limited to the capacity of the Open Class goat barn.** Paid entries will be housed first, followed by exhibit-only animals. No exceptions.
- **No full-body clipping allowed on the grounds.** Small touch-ups and udder clipping is allowed.
- Animal's age will be computed as of the date of the show.
- **No horns allowed on dairy goats.**
- The showing of each breed will be completed before the next breed starts.
- **All milking dairy goats: milk out prior to the day of the show will be 5-7pm and will be checked.**
- **Nursing bucks born after July 1, 2026 will be allowed at Fair. No other bucks are allowed.**

- Each exhibitor/owner is limited to **two animals per class.** See exceptions for group classes.
- **All animals in group classes must also be entered in individual classes.**
- Each exhibitor is required to have a **herd sign.** Decorations are encouraged.
- **Pens must be cleaned and bedded daily by 9am.** Exhibitors are expected to make sure their animals have feed and water at all times and are encouraged to be in attendance during Fair hours.
- Any animal showing signs of illness or contagious diseases will not be allowed. In case of a dispute, a veterinarian will be called at the owner's expense.
- Exhibitors will be required to wear appropriate, clean clothing in the show ring. No sandals, tank tops, tube tops, or shorts.
- The order of the show can be changed at the Superintendent's discretion.

## JUNIOR CLASSES:

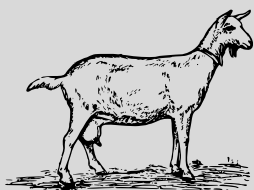
331	Junior Doe Kid, born April 1 - June 30, 2026
332	Intermediate Doe Kid, born March 1 - March 31, 2026
333	Senior Doe Kid, born January 1 - February 29, 2026
334	Junior Yearling, born July 31 - December 31, 2025
335	Dry Yearling Doe, born January 1 - July 30, 2025
337	Junior Breeders Trio: from classes 331-335, all bred and owned by exhibitor. Limited to one entry per exhibitor.
338	Junior Get of Sire: 3 does sired by the same buck from classes 331-335. Limited to one entry per exhibitor. Cross-ownership allowed.

**Awards: Champion and Reserve Champion Junior Doe** (Fair award only; 1st and 2nd place winners from each division in classes 331-335 are eligible to compete), **Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Junior Doe** (Fair award only; Champion does from each Division are eligible to compete)

## GROUP CLASSES:

339	Senior Get of Sire: 3 Does sired by same Buck, all in milk, from classes 323-328. One entry by same Buck per exhibitor. Cross-ownership allowed.
340	Senior Breeders Trio: from classes 323-328, all bred and owned by exhibitor, 1 entry per exhibitor
341	Produce of Dam: 2 does produce of same Dam. One entry by same Dam per exhibitor. Show name of Dam on entry form.
342	Dam & Daughter: both owned by same exhibitor, daughter does not need to be in milk, 2 entries per exhibitor
343	Multi-Generation Family: 3 or more generations represented (Dam, Daughter, Granddaughters, etc.), all owned by same exhibitor. 2 entries per exhibitor.
344	Dairy Herd: 4 Does in milk, all owned by same exhibitor. Each exhibitor limited to one entry.
