Open Class check-in is at the Open Class Beef/Sheep barn.

All exhibitors must have breed-appropriate registration papers. Younger Youth is also required to check-in. Call Kim if arriving after 2pm.

Release & Pen Break-Down: Sunday morning, 8/9. NO EARLY LOAD-OUTS FOR OPEN CLASS.

Show Schedule: Wednesday, 8/5 at 3pm*, Open Class Show Ring
*Time may vary

At check-in, exhibitors must have breed-appropriate registration papers and paperwork or ID that proves participation in the Scrapie Program.

Rules for Open Class Meat Goats

- See Livestock Rules & Regulations on pages 2-3.
- Entries in the goat departments will be limited to the capacity of the Open Class goat barn. Paid entries will be housed first, followed by exhibit-only animals. No exceptions.
- Each exhibitor/owner is limited to **two animals per class**. See exceptions for group classes.
- **All animals in group classes must also be entered in individual classes.**
- **Only nursing bucks born after July 1, 2026 will be allowed at fair.** No other bucks.
- Each exhibitor is required to have a **herd sign**. Decorations are encouraged.
- **Pens must be cleaned and bedded daily by 9am.** Exhibitors are expected to make sure their animals have feed and water at all times and are encouraged to be in attendance during Fair hours.
- Any animal showing signs of illness or contagious diseases will not be allowed. In case of a dispute, a veterinarian will be called at the owner's expense.
- Exhibitors will be required to wear appropriate, clean clothing in the show ring. No sandals, tank tops, tube tops, or shorts.

| 401 | Junior Doe, older than 3 months old; younger than 6 mos. |
| 402 | Junior Doe, at least 6 months old; younger than 9 months |
| 403 | Junior Doe: at least 9 months old; younger than 12 months |

Fair awards *only*, for classes 400-403.

Awards: **Champion and Reserve Champion Junior Doe** (1st and 2nd place Junior does are eligible to compete in *Junior Drive*), **Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Junior Doe** (for each division), **Champion and Reserve Champion Doe** (for each division, all classes)

YEARLING CLASSES:

| 405 | Intermediate Doe, at least 12 months old; younger than 16 months |
| 406 | Intermediate Doe, at least 16 months old; younger than 20 months |
| 407 | Intermediate Doe, 20-24 months old |

Awards: **Champion and Reserve Champion Yearling Doe** (1st and 2nd place Yearling does are eligible to compete in *Yearling Drive*), **Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Yearling Doe** (for each division), **Champion and Reserve Champion Doe** (for each division, all classes)

SENIOR CLASSES:

| 409 | Senior Doe, older than 24 months; younger than 36 months |
| 410 | Senior Doe, at least 36 months old, younger than 48 mos. |
| 411 | Senior Doe, 48+ months old |

Awards: **Champion and Reserve Champion Senior Doe** (1st and 2nd place Senior does are eligible to compete in *Senior Drive*), **Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Senior Doe** (for each division), **Champion and Reserve Champion Doe** (for each division, all classes)

GROUP CLASSES:

| 412 | Dam & Daughter, both owned by exhibitor |
| 413 | Get of Sire: 3 Does from classes 400-411, sired by the same buck. One entry by same buck per exhibitor. Cross-ownership allowed. |
| 414 | Breeders Trio: from classes 400-411. Each exhibitor limited to one entry. |
| 415 | Produce of Dam: 2 does from same Dam. One entry by same Dam per exhibitor. Show name of Dam on entry form. |
| 416 | Multi-Generation Family: 3 or more Generations (Dam, Daughter, Granddaughter, etc.) Owned by Exhibitor, 2 entries per exhibitor. |

Note: kids will follow Dam divisions for all specialty classes (for example, a Percentage kid from a Full Blood/Purebred dam will show in the Full Blood/Purebred division.

Awards: **Grand and Reserve Grand Champion** (for each division), **Best Doe in Show** (Grand and Reserve Grand Champions from each Division eligible to compete)
