*At check-in, exhibitors must have breed-appropriate registration papers and paperwork or ID that proves participation in the Scrapie Program.*

### Rules for Open Class Fiber Goats

- See Livestock Rules & Regulations on pages 2-3.
- Entries in the goat departments will be limited to the capacity of the Open Class goat barn. Paid entries will be housed first, followed by exhibit-only animals. No exceptions.
- Each exhibitor/owner is limited to **two animals per class**. See exceptions for group classes.
- **All animals in group classes must also be entered in individual classes.**
- **Only nursing bucks born after July 1, 2026 will be allowed at fair.** No other bucks.
- Each exhibitor is required to have a **herd sign**. Decorations are encouraged.
- **Pens must be cleaned and bedded daily by 9am.** Exhibitors are expected to make sure their animals have feed and water at all times and are encouraged to be in attendance during Fair hours.
- Any animal showing signs of illness or contagious diseases will not be allowed. In case of a dispute, a veterinarian will be called at the owner's expense.
- Exhibitors will be required to wear appropriate, clean clothing in the show ring. No sandals, tank tops, tube tops, or shorts.

**Younger Youth** must use Younger Youth entry form; exhibitor must enter in Open Class OR Younger Youth Livestock Show and not both.

*Note: If there are fewer than 10 entries in a division class, they may be combined with another division.*

*Note: Cashmere exhibitors please bring fleece from last shearing. Fleece may also be entered in the Open Class Fiber department at no cost.*

374	Wether, Kids & Yearlings, less than 24 months old

376	Best Herd: 3 goats, all owned by the exhibitor (judged on consistency and breed)
377	Dam & Produce (improvement)
378	Pairs, either sex (consistency)

Awards: **Champion and Reserve Champion** (1st & 2nd place winners in classes 370-374 are eligible), **Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Doe** (division champions are eligible), **Best in Show** (best of all divisions), **Best Fiber on the Goat** (best of all divisions), **Champion Fiber Goat**

### Rules for Open Class Fiber Goats

- All fleeces must have been shorn within 12 months of the opening date of Fair (8/5/26) and will be disqualified if more than 13 months of growth.
- All exhibitors are limited to **2 fleeces per class**.
- All entries must be shorn from animals owned by the exhibitor.
- The exhibit tag (obtained from the Fairgrounds Office or this department's superintendent must show the name and address of the exhibitor, breed of goat, and class number.
- Fleeces can be rejected if improperly prepared.

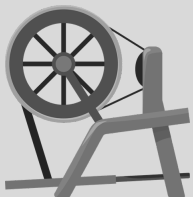
