At check-in, exhibitors must have breed-appropriate registration papers and paperwork or ID that proves participation in the Scrapie Program.

Rules for Open Class Pack Goats & Goat Obstacle Course

- See Livestock Rules & Regulations on pages 2-3.
- Only wethers and does that have never freshened will be allowed.
- Competition is open to all breeds of goats.
- Collars with leads or halters will be accepted.
- 3 refusals of an obstacle and the goat will be required to move on to the next obstacle. This is not a timed event.
- The course will be 6-10 obstacles with bonus point obstacles available. Examples of obstacles include: teeter-totter, raised plank, tire stack, rain, tent, water hazard (pond), step-through, back-up, flag, balloons, step over logs, limb dragging, bridge, brush, etc.
- Each obstacle will be performed for up to 10 points; 0 points for a refusal and 10 points for perfect execution.

- Goats with horns may be required to have safety features attached to the horns, at the discretion of the superintendent and Fair management.
- For Pack Goats, all participants must have the appropriate amount of weight on their goat for its age and size:
 - 0-12 months old: soft pack, no weight required
 - 1-2 years old: 10% of body weight
 - 3+ years old: 20% of body weight
- Exhibitors will be required to wear appropriate, clean clothing in the show ring. No sandals, tank tops, tube tops, or shorts.
