### **Rules for Open Class Cavies**

- See **Livestock Rules & Regulations** on pages 2-3.
- Exhibitors must provide their own bedding.
- Pens must be cleaned and bedded by 9am each day.
- 4-H or FFA members' animals that are dually entered into Open Class **must be housed with 4-H/FFA**. If an animal is entered into Open Class only, it **must be housed with Open Class**.
- Animals that are dually entered in 4-H/FFA must still pay the Open Class entry fee.
- No animal shall be admitted or allowed to remain on the grounds if they show evidence of any infectious or contagious disease, or unsightly condition.
- All animals must be vet checked before being placed in their assigned cages/pens.
- No cavy younger than 3 months old will be permitted.
