Rules for Open Class Poultry

- See Livestock Rules & Regulations on pages 2-3.
- Exhibitors must provide their own bedding.
- Pens must be cleaned and bedded by 9am each day.
- 4-H or FFA members' animals that are dually entered into Open Class *must be housed with 4-H/FFA. If an animal is entered into Open Class only, it must be housed with Open Class.*
- Animals that are dually entered in 4-H/FFA must still pay the Open Class entry fee.
- No animal shall be admitted or allowed to remain on the grounds if they show evidence of any infectious or contagious disease, or unsightly condition.
- All animals must be vet checked before being placed in their assigned cages/pens.
- **All animals competing as pairs and trios must also be entered as individuals.**

Younger Youth must use Younger Youth entry form; exhibitor must enter in Open Class OR Younger Youth Livestock Show and not both.

Younger Youth Poultry will show on Friday, 8/7, around lunch time. Be present.
