### Rules for Open Class Photography

- See Static Exhibit General Info on page 4.
- **One photograph per exhibitor per class.** Adults may enter in either an age class OR the Professional class, **not both.**
- **Photographs must be original to the exhibitor, taken in the last 2 years, and not previously exhibited at the Crook County Fair.**
- **Exhibitor's name, address, and phone number must be visible on the back of each entry.**
- **Exhibit tags** are available at the Fairgrounds Office through 7/31 and then at CFH on drop-off day.
- Do not enter a photograph under "miscellaneous" if you are entering a similar photo into a regular class.
- Photographs entered into the print divisions (784, 786, 788, 789, 791) **must be mounted on poster board with no more than 1" border.** Matted photos will not be allowed in these divisions. Do not mount on foam core.
- Photographs entered in the enlargement divisions (785, 787, 792) can be **mounted on poster board OR matted.** Do not mount on foam core.
- Photographs that have been digitally altered or enhanced should be entered in DIVISION 792. Tape the original, unaltered 4x6" print version to the back of the entry.
- No frames or glass will be allowed except for in DIVISION 790: "Framed Prints".
- **Photos, matte boards, and poster boards must be free of words or embellishments,** except for in classes 788 & 789.
- **Professional photographers: enter under the "Prof." class.** A professional photographer is someone who sells, markets, and displays their photography throughout the year and makes a living from doing so.

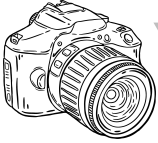

### Rules for Open Class Hobbies & Crafts

- See Static Exhibit General Info on page 4.
- Exhibitors may enter 2 exhibits per class.
- Exhibit tags are available at the Fairgrounds Office through 7/31, then at CFH on drop-off day.
- All entries must be clean.
- All entries must be mounted to a base and/or portable, with NO LOOSE PARTS. No wall-mounted displays.
- School projects should be entered under a Youth class in the applicable Division, provided they are the exhibitor's own design and work.
- Collections may be re-entered after 2 years, providing the collection has been significantly added to/improved.
- Hired security will be inside Carey Foster Hall during Fair hours. However, the Fairgrounds is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items.
- "Display Only" exhibits must be approved by the Superintendent in advance. Space is very limited.
- The Superintendent has the right to reassign an entry to the appropriate division and/or class.
- Classes may be divided or combined as needed, at the discretion of the Superintendent.
- 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place awards are based on merit. If there is only one entry in a class, it may not get a placing if the judge feels it does not meet the standards.
