

- Purchase via FairEntry or by order form with check located on the <u>Fair Merchandise</u> page at <u>www.danecountyfair.com</u>.
- Shirts will be distributed with packets to Club/Chapter Leaders at pick up on June 26.
- Color will be Orange
 - \$13/shirt for XS-XL
 - \$15/shirt for 2XL
 - \$16/shirt for 3XL and 4XL



ENTRIES - FAIRENTRY

- Entry process will remain the same online through <u>FairEntry</u>.
 - Opens April 17, 2024, Closes Saturday, June 1, 2024 at 11:59pm.
 - Payments will be processed by credit card via FairEntry or check (by June 9) mailed directly to the Fair Office (PO Box 287, Oregon, WI 53575).
 - Entries, shavings/bedding, Fair shirts, privacy panels, etc. all processed through FairEntry.
 - <u>Family admission wristbands & day tickets</u> (**NEW**) will <u>NOT</u> be processed through FairEntry & will use a <u>new ticketing system</u>.
 - Guide to Entries & Exhibitor Resource Great reference tool!
 - Late Entries will be accepted for \$25/submission June 2-8, 2024, 11:59pm. Submission is defined as one or multiple Department/Class/Lot entries in one transaction per exhibitor. Entries will NOT be accepted after 6/8.

ENTRIES - FAIRENTRY

- After June 1, Club/Chapter Leaders will receive an email summary of member exhibitors, entries, and fees. Leaders
 MUST review and reply to the email with approval by NOON on June 9.
 - Late entries will be shared as received (June 2-8).
- Club/Chapter Leader entry tag packet pick-up will be on June 26 (5pm-7pm) at AEC Exhibition Hall.
- NEW THIS YEAR
 - Entry fee is \$8 & ALL youth entries will receive a season wristband to the Fair (including Cloverbuds).
 - Family Season Wristbands & Day Tickets (NEW) ability to purchase through our new ticketing site and NOT through FairEntry.
 - Verify Department Class & Lot in the <u>Premium Book</u> as some have changed or were added.
 - <u>Department 35</u> Enter a group school or school class/club project entry at the Fair! <u>CLICK HERE</u> to view the information packet with more details on how to enter group exhibits. Students who participate in the school or school class/club entry will receive complimentary admission to the Fair for one day.

ENTRIES - FAIRENTRY REMINDERS

- Exhibitors MUST select the Club/Chapter you are submitting the entry under (4-H, FFA, etc.)
- Select Exhibitor Entry Fee & Season Wristband (\$8.00) for individual entries NOT Club Entry (\$0.00)
- Make sure to register ALL entries for EACH EXHIBITOR in the family BEFORE clicking SUBMIT.
 - Once submitted, two emails will be received. Only AFTER the 2nd email approving entries, can you add additional items or entries. To remove any item or for any questions, contact the Fair Entries Dept. at entries.danecountyfair@gmail.com or 608-889-0026 (not 4-H).
- 01-Fair Orders includes options for T-shirts, shavings/bedding, etc. and NOT FAMILY ADMISSION
 - <u>Family discounted wristband & day tickets</u> are to be purchased through the Fair's <u>NEW ticketing system</u> through the link noted in FairEntry. They <u>cannot</u> be ordered with entries through FairEntry. Those with a wristband/day ticket may enter through Gate 3 and park in the North Lot.
 - Youth Season Wristband (\$10) & Day Ticket (\$5) for youth family members attending the Fair, but NOT exhibiting
 - Adult Season Wristband (\$20) & Day Ticket (\$8) adult family members attending the Fair

ENTRIES - FAIRENTRY

- <u>Youth Animal Exhibitor Code of Practice</u> reference and acknowledgement in FairEntry when processing entries. The Code of Practice for all youth and their family members is listed in the Premium Book and on the website. Make sure to thoroughly read the Code of Practice; it touches on some of the following:
 - Treatment of animals
 - Proof of animal ownership; false ownership is illegal.
 - The use of drugs in animals
 - Any violation of the Code of Practice results in a forfeit of premiums and awards, disqualification for the youth exhibitor for the present Fair year, and a minimum one-year suspension from showing livestock at the Dane County Fair for the youth exhibitor and immediate family members and may result in a loss of eligibility for future shows. Possible civil penalties may be imposed by the proper authorities based on evidence provided by the show of exhibitors in violation of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic act/or the animal mistreatment, neglect and abandonment laws that apply on the local, state, and national levels.

ANIMAL PROJECTS (1-11, 13)

- Majority of the schedule is similar to 2023; refer to the Premium Book for Department details.
 - Move-in is Wednesday, July 17 from 12:00pm-8:00pm; swine and sheep start at 9:00am.
 - All market animals MUST arrive by 7:00pm.
 - Showring Schedule as of 4/15/24
 - Move-out will be on Sunday, July 21 at 6:30pm (tack at 5:30pm). (Sale Animals 4pm Sheep, 4:30pm Beef & Swine)
- Additional animal health regulations will be required for some species; refer to the Premium Book.
- Education requirements submission deadline is June 15 via online form. CLICK HERE to view education offerings and Education Requirement Card for Animals and Horse & Pony (separate cards).
 - ALL education cards MUST be submitted through the Dane County Fair by June 15. If you have a question


Rockstars in the Ring



NON-ANIMAL PROJECTS (10-34)

- Foods & Nutrition ONLY will be held Monday, July 15 in Exhibit Hall A; view Department information in Premium Book for check-in and judging times.
- Project check-in & judging will be held Tuesday, July 16 in Exhibit Hall B & C during the times listed for each Department; all but a few departments are 1:00pm-7:00pm.
- NEW: Check-out will be held Sunday, July 21 from 4:30pm-6:30pm only.
 - Enter WEST doors from South Parking Lot to access Exhibition Hall, NOT North Doors. Exit through Dock. Animal exhibitors may Exit through North Doors.

 - ALL participants are required to participate in Class I: Wildlife Ecology Knowledge Challenge on May 18 or June 29; see Premium Book for details.

OTHER FAIR UPDATES

- Gates will remain open from 8:00am-8:00pm and physically close at 8:00pm. Attendees may only exit between 8:00pm-11:00pm; Fair closes each day at 11:00pm.
 - Gate 3 (between Pavilions) Exhibitor ONLY Gate Youth Exhibitors and Family with wristbands/day tickets are able to access the grounds after 8:00pm through Gate 3 ONLY. Your Fair wristband must be shown to gain access to the grounds at all times. Those without wristbands/day tickets must enter Gates 1 or 2.
- The Fair Office will be on the 1st Floor of the Exhibition Hall in Mendota 1. The Entries Department will be next door in Mendota 2.
- **NEW** ticketing system & Gates 1 & 2 will be drive-up = online tickets scanned <u>or</u> new tickets purchased (credit card or cash) at gates, attendees receive a day wristband, then park and access the grounds via the security walk-up entrance. All wristbands <u>must</u> be worn in order to enter the Fair.
 - Exhibitor & Exhibitor Family Season Wristbands can be shown to ticket sellers at Gates 1 & 2 if needed.

 - Music = Madison County (Thu), Totally Neon (Fri), Wisconsin Singers (Sat afternoon), Life 102.5 Concert with ~two artists (Sat), LaMovida contests and bands (Sun)
- <u>Camping</u> if camping at the DCF, exhibitor camping can be in the North Lot or on Willow Island.
