- 3) Learning Lane Display Booth (booth is not judged - no premiums awarded) - May represent one of the following species: Dairy, Beef, Cavy, Exotic-domestic, Goat, Horse, Poultry, Sheep, Rabbit or Swine. Please specify on entry. To focus on one topic (ex: breeds, size, color, nutrition, general or unique facts, body parts, products produced by specie, etc.) Displays will be located near the specie housing location in Learning Lane (center aisle) in the Pavilions or within the Arena Building for swine. Past Vet-Sci displays may also be displayed.
