- Garments entered under Dept. 27 - Knitting and Crocheting may also be entered under Clothing Revue and Knitting & Crocheting Revue (see classes Q - V). See page 70 for the Revue information.
- All exhibits must have entry tags fastened securely to the article (safety pins recommended). Include age on entry tag. No hangers please.
- A 3"x5" card listing fiber content, proper care and intended use must be securely attached to the article.
- Exhibitors may enter only one class: Beginning, Intermediate, or Advanced, choose the most appropriate. No limit to lots entered in the chosen class.
- All articles must be handmade.
- Violation of these rules may result in a lower placing.
