    - o REMINDER: All youth exhibitor entries include a wristband to the Fair (including Cloverbuds).
    - Late Entries will be accepted for a \$25/submission June 2-8, 2024, 11:59 p.m. Submission is defined as one
      or multiple Department/Class/Lot entries in one transaction per exhibitor.
    - o **Entry Requirements**: summarizes the entry limits for Departments.

#### Department FairEntry Notes:

- ANIMALS:
  - All exhibitors MUST enter Showmanship in the species they exhibit at the Fair (except Horse & Pony).
     Exhibitors who are not entered in showmanship will automatically be entered prior to the Fair. If an exhibitor does not wish to participate in showmanship, they can scratch on-site at the Fair.
  - Market Animals do not have to be eligible for the Meat Animal Sale in order to be eligible for the championship drive.

#### > POULTRY:

Review Animal Health Requirements. Poultry must test negative for Mycoplasma Gallisepticum or a
DATCP-issued Certificate. OR, Individually test mature birds, must be wing or leg banded, and test
negative for pullorum-typhoid. See animal health requirements for complete details.

#### SWINE (NEW LOCATION – Pavilion 2):

- o Non-Terminal show: Must have PRRS, PEDv tests completed and listed on CVI.
- Use of Ractopamine (Paylean) in DCF swine is prohibited.
