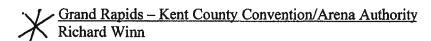

MINUTES OF THE GRAND RAPIDS-KENT COUNTY CONVENTION/ARENA AUTHORITY BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING Friday, December 7, 2012

1. Call to Order

Steve Heacock, Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. Birgit Klohs, Secretary/Treasurer, recorded the meeting minutes. Chair Heacock removed item #6 from the agenda.

2. Economic Impact Analysis

Erin Grover and Alex Rosaen of Anderson Economic Group (AEG) attended the meeting to present the economic impact study of DeVos Place®, DeVos Performance Hall, and the Van Andel Arena®. Ms. Grover explained that the analysis is a report card to investors and a vehicle to move forward. AEG is a consulting firm specializing in economics, financial valuation, market analysis, and public policy, with offices located in East Lansing and Chicago. Anderson Economic Group serves both public and private organizations including governments, corporations, nonprofit organizations, trade associations, and small businesses. AEG's clients include: the States of Michigan, North Carolina, Wisconsin; cities of Detroit, Cincinnati, Norfolk, and Fort Wayne; counties of Oakland, MI and Collier, FL; Meijer, Spartan Stores, General Motors, Ford, Delphi, Honda, Detroit Lions, PG&E Generating, Labatt USA, Nestle, InBev USA, Gambrinus; Experience Grand Rapids, MSU, U of M, Wayne State, Van Andel Institute, Michigan Manufacturers Association, United Ways of Michigan, and Automation Alley.

The CAA commissioned AEG to estimate the economic impact of the CAA venues on Kent County, quantify the new economic activity that the venues and their attendees generate for the local economy, and examine other long-term benefits of the venues and their events. AEG isolated Fiscal Year 2011 and for that year quantify new economic activity that each venue and their attendees generated for the local economy.

Ms. Grover explained the AEG's approach in reaching its conclusions. AEG first defined "net economic impact," which is new economic activity directly or indirectly created by the venues and activities of the CAA. Net economic impact included only economic activity from spending that would not have occurred without CAA venues and events and excluded any activity by venues or attendees that displaced other activity in Kent County. Expenditures made by the venues included payroll and health care expenditures; concessions, catering, and other expenditures to vendors. Expenditures by attendees and visiting performers included restaurants, accommodations, incidental expenses (gas, parking).

Three measures of economic impact included output (additional spending on goods and services); earnings (additional income to households); and employment (new jobs). AEG met with staff to discuss data needs and facility financial information, collected expenditure and attendance data from numerous reliable sources (CAA, SMG, Griffins Hockey team, TicketMaster, ESRI, Inc., Grand Action, Bureau of Labor Statistics, Senate Fiscal Agency, and *The Grand Rapids Press*), and from there developed a custom model to estimate each venue's economic impact on Kent County.

The economic impact analysis found that, for Fiscal Year 2011:

- 1. The three venues hosted over 1.1 million attendees in FY 2011, with nearly 540,000 coming from outside of Kent County.
 - Ticket purchasers for events at the Arena and Performance Hall in FY 2011 were from every state in the U.S. Over 10% of tickets purchased came from outside of Michigan, including 406 from Canada.
- 2. The venue operations and events contributed over \$32.7 million in net new spending within Kent County in FY 2011.
 - CAA venues spent over \$8.1 million with Kent County businesses and individuals for event operations and capital expenditures. Spending by attendees and visiting performers outside of the venues totaled over \$24.6 million (restaurants, accommodations, gas, parking, etc.)
- 3. The total economic impact from the venues, in FY 2011, was over \$58.4 million, generating nearly 700 jobs and \$16.6 million in new earnings for households in Kent County.
 - DeVos Place® generated \$26.1 million in output, \$6.8 million in earnings, and 314 jobs; Van Andel Arena® produced \$22.2 million in output, \$6 million in earnings, and 252 jobs; DeVos Performance Hall generated \$9.9 million in output, \$2.6 million in earnings, and 132 jobs.

3. Minutes of Prior Meeting

Motion by Mr. Wilson, support by Mr. Chamberlin, to approve the November 2, 2012, Minutes. Motion carried.

4. Committee Reports

a. Operations Committee

Mr. Chamberlin stated that the Operations Committee met earlier this morning and he has nothing further to add.

b. <u>Finance Committee</u>

i. CAA October 2012 Financial Statements

Motion: Ms. Klohs, supported by Mr. Heartwell, moved to accept the CAA Financial Statements for the period ended October 31, 2012. The motion carried unanimously.

ii. SMG October 2012 Financial Statements

Motion: Ms. Klohs, supported by Mr. Chamberlin, moved to accept the SMG Financial Statements for DeVos Place® and the Van Andel Arena® for the period ended October 31, 2012. The motion carried unanimously.

Chair Heacock stated that two items were brought up at a recent Kent County Commission meeting, one being the public disclosure of CAA financials and financial support for Experience Grand Rapids and the West Michigan Sports Commission. Staff is looking into the possibility of posting the financial statements on the website. Mr. White stated that the financial statements are posted on the State of Michigan site already. Chair Heacock explained to the Commission that the CAA is very purposeful in maintaining a healthy reserve to keep the buildings viable. The CAA does contract with both the Sports Commission and Experience Grand Rapids for services.

5. SMG Report and Facilities Calendars

Mr. MacKeigan stated that Anderson Economic Group was great to work with, very cooperative, and available. Fiscal year 2011 was the base-level year, and possibly follow-up studies could be done every five or ten years.

6. Public Comment

None.

7. Adjournment

The meeting adjourned at 9:00 a.m.

The attached interim Balance Sheet, Administrative Income Statement, and Consolidated Income Statement are formatted to provide information concerning the Convention/Arena Authority administrative accounts.

These statements are prepared on a cash basis. The Balance Sheet includes a two-year comparative financial position at December 31 for Fiscal Years 2012 and 2013. The Administrative Income Statement provides a line item comparison of accounts for the current fiscal year as compared to a similar period in the prior fiscal year. In addition, the Administrative Income Statement provides a comparison of current year budget to prior year (FY 2012). It will allow the reader to compare expenditure trends with full-year budgetary allowances. The Consolidated Income Statement is formatted by functional area. The columnar format is the same as in the Administrative Income Statement.

Items of interest in the six month financial statements are explained as follows:

Balance Sheet (Unconsolidated):

- The cash and investments position is up by \$120,000 from June 30, 2012. This is better than the budget forecast.
- Fund balance increased by \$75,000 from the December 31, 2011 level.

December Administrative Revenue/Expense:

- Parking Revenues continues a negative trend, at a decline of (7.2%), as the normal October monthly deposit was delayed.
- Parking Management Expense is down by (66.1%), as the prior-year expense included a non-recurring \$57,715 for seal coating/striping at the DeVos Place® ramp.

- DID Assessment The FY2012 DID assessment was received and paid September 2011. Year-to-date (FY 2013), no invoices have been received from the City.
- Overall Expense. Operating expenses are budgeted at a 5.3% annual increase. For the current fiscal year, six months' actual operating expenses totaled a (4.4%) decrease from prior year.
 Year-to-date total overall operating expense (six months) comprises 38.6% of annual budget.

Consolidated Income Statement (six months):

- The Van Andel Arena® budget forecast a current year "Net Proceeds" increase of +12.9%. For the current fiscal year, "Net Proceeds," are reported at an increase of 31.6% from prior-year performance. This was a significant turnaround from the prior month. The November report, five months' activity, trended at a negative (1.7%) when compared to prior year.
- The DeVos Place® budget forecast a current year "Net Proceeds" decrease of (62.5%). For the current fiscal year, "Net Proceeds" are reported at 99.7% ahead of prior-year performance.
- Total operating "Net Proceeds" are up by +\$679,443 from a like period in the prior fiscal year.
 The full-year consolidated operating budget forecasted a full-year decline of (\$107,689) in "Net Proceeds." Actual performance is running significantly ahead of budget, driven primarily by the increased operating revenue at DeVos Place*.

These reports are intended to provide a summary analysis of administrative activities over the course of the fiscal year.
