MINUTES OF THE GRAND RAPIDS-KENT COUNTY CONVENTION/ARENA AUTHORITY BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING Friday, May 5, 2011

1. Call to Order

Steve Heacock, Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 9:05 a.m. Susan Waddell recorded the meeting minutes in the absence of Secretary/Treasurer Birgit Klohs. Chair Heacock rearranged the agenda by moving up items 4 and 5.

2. Minutes of Prior Meeting

Motion: Mr. Tomaselli, supported by Mr. Wilson, moved to approve the Minutes of the April 1, 2011, meeting of the Grand Rapids-Kent County Convention/Arena Authority. The motion carried unanimously.

3. Resolution Approving and Authorizing Execution of Management Agreement with SMG

Attorney Dick Wendt stated that the CAA retained the professional services of consultant Susan Seger, who has negotiated hundreds of management agreements. And the consultant, after comprehensive review, concluded that the terms were very reasonable and within industry norms.

Attorney Wendt reviewed a comparison of key provisions between the existing and proposed management agreements between the CAA and SMG.

Boardmember Tomaselli, supported by Boardmember Wilson, moved the adoption of the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the current Management Agreement, as amended between the Grand Rapids-Kent County Convention/Arena Authority (the "CAA"), and SMG dated as of July 1, 2006, terminates on June 30, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the CAA and SMG have negotiated a new Management Agreement to be dated and effective July 1, 2011 (the "Management Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the CAA Board desires to approve and authorize the execution of the Management Agreement substantially in the form presented at this meeting.

RESOLVED:

- 1. That the Management Agreement substantially in the form presented at this meeting is hereby approved with such modifications not materially adverse to the CAA approved as to content by the CAA Chairman and as to form by the CAA's legal counsel and the Chairman is authorized and directed to execute the approved Management Agreement for and on behalf of the CAA.
- 2. That all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict herewith shall be, and the same are hereby, rescinded to the extent of such conflict.

Motion approved unanimously.

Mr. Wendt stated that he is working with SMG on a letter agreement that would change the relationship of Rich MacKeigan as a CAA employee. Under the letter agreement, the CAA would engage SMG for Rich to provide services.

4. Resolution Approving and Authorizing Execution of Food and Beverage Services Agreement with SMG Food and Beverage LLC

Attorney Dick Wendt stated that the CAA retained the professional services of consultant Chris Bigelow, who assisted and advised regarding the original food and beverage agreement with SMGFB. And the consultant, after comprehensive review, concluded that the terms were very reasonable and within industry norms. Attorney Wendt reviewed a comparison of key provisions between the existing and proposed food and beverage service agreements between the CAA and SMG Food and Beverage LLC.

Boardmember Tomaselli, supported by Boardmember Wilson, moved the adoption of the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the current Food and Beverage Services Agreement, as amended, between the Grand Rapids-Kent County Convention/Arena Authority (the "CAA"), and SMG Food and Beverage, LLC dated as of July 1, 2006, terminates on June 30, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the CAA and SMG have negotiated a new Food and Beverage Services Agreement to be dated and effective July 1, 2011 (the "F&B Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the CAA Board desires to approve and authorize the execution of the F&B Agreement substantially in the form presented at this meeting.

RESOLVED:

- 1. That the F&B Agreement substantially in the form presented at this meeting is hereby approved with such modifications not materially adverse to the CAA approved as to content by the CAA Chairman and as to form by the CAA's legal counsel and the Chairman is authorized and directed to execute the approved F&B Agreement for and on behalf of the CAA.
- 2. That all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict herewith shall be, and the same are hereby, rescinded to the extent of such conflict.

Resolution approved unanimously.

5. <u>Committee Reports</u>

A. Finance Committee

Motion: Mr. Tomaselli, supported by Mr. Wilson, moved to approve: (i) the SMG Financial Statements for DeVos Place® and the Van Andel Arena® for the period ended March 31, 2011; (ii) the CAA Financial Statements for the period ended March 31, 2011; and the Third Quarter Consolidated Financial Statement. After review and discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

The Finance Committee earlier reviewed the proposed FY 2012 Budgets and DeVos Place® Rate Sheets in detail and will hold a short meeting on Friday, June 3, 2011, to take formal action on these items.

B. <u>DeVos Place® Parking Operation Agreement</u>

Boardmember Tomaselli, supported by Boardmember Wilson, moved the adoption of the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Grand Rapids-Kent County Convention/Arena Authority (the "CAA") controls the operation of DeVos Place, a performing arts/convention/entertainment facility (the "Convention Center") including 690 parking spaces located in the lower level of the Convention Center (the "Parking Spaces"); and

WHEREAS, the CAA and the City of Grand Rapids (the "City") previously entered into a Parking Operation Agreement dated July 1, 2008, related to the Parking Spaces which expires June 30, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the CAA and the City desire to continue their relationship with respect to the Parking Spaces for a three year term beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2014, and have agreed to enter into a new Parking Operation Agreement (the "Agreement") setting forth the terms and conditions for the operation of the Parking Spaces.

RESOLVED:

1. That the Agreement substantially in the form presented at this meeting with such minor deviations as are not materially adverse to the CAA and approved as to content by the CAA Chairman and as to form by the CAA's counsel is approved.

Convention/Arena Authority Meeting May 5, 2011 – 4

- 2. That the Chairman of the CAA is authorized and directed to execute the Agreement for and on behalf of the City.
- 3. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith shall be, and the same are hereby, rescinded to the extent of such conflict.

Resolution adopted unanimously.

C. Operations Committee

Mr. Chamberlin stated that the proposed FY 2012 budgets, and in particular the capital budget, will be presented to the Operations Committee on June 3.

Mr. Helmstead provided an overview of the CVB's recent sales activities, marketing efforts, and major bid presentations.

6. SMG Report and Facilities Calendar

Mr. MacKeigan presented a summary of the upcoming events that will be held at Van Andel Arena® and DeVos Place®.

7. Public Comment

None.

8. Next Meeting Date

Updates to Memorandum Dated May 3, 2011

On May 5, the CAA Finance Committee reviewed a preliminary draft of the consolidated Fiscal Year 2012 budget request. It has forecast "estimated" revenues totaling \$10,992,124 with an operating/capital budget request of \$11,277,593. The estimated draw on fund balance amounted to \$285,469.

In the interim, the Fiscal Year 2011 estimates and Fiscal Year 2012 budget recommendations have been amended in the following manner:

- Table B Reduce Van Andel parking revenue estimate by \$30,000. On May 24, the City Commission adopted Fiscal Year 2012 event and monthly parking rates reduced from levels originally recommended in April.
- Table B Add a capital project titled "Escalator Safety Strips" in the amount of \$25,000.
- Table B Increase the Fiscal Year 2011 Miscellaneous Revenue estimate by \$250,000 to reflect a capital contribution to be made by SMG. This contribution is required under Section 6 of the Food and Beverage Agreement approved on May 5.

As a result of these changes, the operating deficit for Fiscal Year 2012 has been increased from \$285,469 to \$340,469. The overall projected fund balance (at 6/30/2012) was increased by a net \$195,000.

It is the staff recommendation to adopt the Fiscal Year 2012 budget as originally recommended with the modifications as noted above. This budget will take effect on July 1, 2011.

The attached material summarizes a requested CAA Administrative Operating Budget and Consolidated Income Statement for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2011 (Fiscal Year 2012). The format of the report provides the Committee with an overview of Fiscal Year 2010 actual, Fiscal Year 2011 estimate, and Fiscal Year 2012 preliminary recommendations. Preliminary Finance Committee review will be held on May 6th with final Board review scheduled for June 3rd.

Table A provides a summary of the facility manager (SMG) budget documents submitted under separate cover. Based on SMG's most recent "budget roll," the current year forecast has been updated to a net operating income balance of \$308,552. Funding, requested for FY 2012, would generate a net operating income of \$245,718.

The Fiscal Year 2012 consolidated income statement (Table C) forecasts a net operating income totaling \$379,531. This income will be applied to finance, in part, a capital outlay request totaling \$926,000. The balance of the funds requested will be supported by interest earnings and a drawdown from the capital reserve account.

Table B provides a summary of the CAA administrative budget. Revenues in this account include regularly scheduled transfers from the facility manager, parking, interest and other miscellaneous contributions to the organization. Expenditures from this account include provision for utilities, capital repair/replacement/improvement (as defined in the SMG management contract), parking management fees, landscape plantings, and other administrative expenses. Table B-1, attached hereto, provides additional details concerning utility and miscellaneous administrative expenditure accounts.

On the basis of these initial budgetary estimates, it is expected that the CAA will close its Fiscal Year 2011 activities with a "fund balance" approximating \$22 million. This would include a recommended minimum operating reserve balance of \$6 million and a capital repair/replacement/improvement reserve of \$16 million.

Prior fiscal year budget recommendations included a Table D entitled "Capital Repair/Replacement/Improvement Reserve – Projection of Receipts, Disbursements and Balances." The table, last prepared as a part of the Fiscal Year 2009 budget, forecasted capital requirements of approximately \$1 million per annum during the period of Fiscal Year 2010 through Fiscal Year 2014, inclusive, rising to an annual level of approximately \$3 million per annum for the following five fiscal years. Allowing for this level of capital requirements, the forecast identified a Fund Balance of \$13 million at June 30, 2019. Table D has not been updated as part of this Fiscal Year 2012 budget request. Funding for an "Arena Long-Term Capital Study" (see Administrative/Other) was approved as a part of the FY 2011 budget, to provide additional assistance in updating the forecast.

Table D has been included along with the original Fiscal Year 2012 budget materials. This report provides a "Budget Summary by Facility/Other" formatted report. It organizes revenues and expenses in three activity areas including Van Andel Arena®, DeVos Place® Convention Center, and other. This report provides all of the same information contained in Table C, but also allows the reader to view the overall operations of each facility incorporating therein the revenues generated by the parking facilities attached or adjacent to the buildings.

Rich MacKeigan, Chris Machuta, Sue Waddell, and I participated in preparation of the attached recommended budget. We would expect to present this to the Finance Committee, at its May meeting, and be prepared to answer any additional questions which may arise from a review of this material.

I would like to take this opportunity to present SMG's recommendations for Room Rental Rates for DeVos Place, effective FY July 2012 through FY June 2016. SMG has established a 5 year rate card for DeVos Place to provide potential clients the option to secure rental rates in outlying years, and in some instances multiple years. Historically, while rental rates at DeVos Place have not increased more than 3.25% each year over the past few years (averaging between 2.75% - 3%); our rates continue to hover in the mid-range on the regional average. Our current pricing schedules reflect current economic assumptions in the regional marketplace and knowledge of rental rates of comparable venues of similar size in the area.

We consider our current five year rate card to be a key marketing element for the facility. Given the flexibility to negotiate rental rates with clients (limited to an increase or reduction no greater than 20% of the approved rates) current rates afford us continued opportunities to be competitive in the bidding process for Regional and National Conventions. By keeping our current 5 year rental rate card, we position ourselves appropriately to deliver the most value for the quality of product we serve.

Within the current structure of the rental rate cards approved by the CAA last fiscal year, SMG is committed to providing the best services required in the marketing of the facilities.

FIRST ADDENDUM TO MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT

THIS FIRST ADDENDUM TO MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT (the "First Addendum") is dated as of July 1, 2011, between the GRAND RAPIDS-KENT COUNTY CONVENTION/ARENA AUTHORITY (the "CAA") and SMG.

RECITALS

- A. The CAA and SMG have entered into a Management Agreement (the "Agreement") dated and effective as of July 1, 2011, for SMG to promote, operate, maintain, market and manage the Arena and Convention Center, collectively referred to as the Facilities, as an independent contractor pursuant to the terms of the Agreement.
- B. The CAA further desires to engage SMG to provide additional services to the CAA outside and beyond the scope of services to be provided by SMG pursuant to the Agreement.
- C. The additional services to be provided by SMG shall be as identified and provided in this First Addendum
- **NOW, THEREFORE,** in consideration of the additional mutual promises, covenants and agreements herein contained, the parties hereto, intending to be legally bound, hereby agree as follows:
- Section 1. Additional Services. Pursuant to the terms and conditions of this Agreement SMG shall provide the additional services identified in Attachment A attached hereto and incorporated herein (the "Additional Services").
- Section 2. Performance of Additional Services. It is agreed by the parties hereto that the Additional Services shall be performed by SMG employee, Richard MacKeigan ("MacKeigan"). MacKeigan shall (a) devote an average of not less than 7 hours per week and not more than 8 hours per week determined on the basis of 48 weeks per Fiscal Year and (b) keep track of the time he devotes to performing the Additional Services so that it may be distinguished from the scope of services MacKeigan performs pursuant to the Agreement as General Manager of the Facilities.
- Section 3. Compensation for Additional Services. SMG shall receive \$30,000 as compensation for the performance of the Additional Services for the first Fiscal Year of the Initial Term. Thereafter, for each Fiscal Year during the Initial Term and the First Renewal Term, if any, and Second Renewal Term, if any, the amount shall be adjusted on the first day of each subsequent Fiscal Year by the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index All Urban Consumers (CPI-U), U.S. city average, during the one year period ending in June immediately preceding such Fiscal Year, as published by the U.S. Department of Labor, *provided*, that for purposes of this adjustment the amount of any decrease below 0% or any increase above 3% yearly should be disregarded. Such amounts shall be paid by the CAA to SMG in quarterly

installments at the end of each calendar quarter. SMG agrees to pay such amounts less normal and customary withholdings to MacKeigan.

- **Section 4. Term.** Subject to early termination as provided in Section 5 hereof, the term of this First Addendum shall run simultaneously with the Initial Term and First Renewal Term and Second Renewal Term, as applicable, in the Agreement.
- Section 5. Early Termination. Either party may terminate this First Addendum at anytime without cause upon 30 days advanced written notice to the other party in accordance with the notice provisions of this Agreement or with less than 30 days written notice for cause. In addition, since the CAA has agreed to enter into this First Addendum based on the representation that the Additional Services will be personally performed by MacKeigan, the CAA may immediately terminate this First Addendum upon written notice to SMG in accordance with the Agreement if MacKeigan shall be unavailable, unwilling or unable to perform the Additional Services. All compensation payable to SMG under this First Addendum shall be prorated to the date of termination and paid to SMG.
- **Section 6. Independent Contractor.** The relationship of SMG to the CAA under this First Addendum shall be that of an independent contractor and nothing contained herein is intended or shall be construed to create or establish a partnership or joint venture between the CAA and SMG. MacKeigan shall be an employee of SMG and shall not be deemed an employee of the CAA for any purpose whatsoever.
- **Section 7.** Amendment. This First Addendum shall not be altered, modified or amended in whole or in part, except in a writing executed by both parties hereto.
- Section 8. Termination of Letter Agreement. On the Effective Date (as hereinafter defined) of this First Addendum the letter agreement dated August 23, 2006, between the CAA and MacKeigan shall terminate.
- **Section 9. Definitions.** Terms used and not defined in this First Addendum shall have those meanings as defined in the Agreement.
- Section 10. Effective Date. This First Addendum is effective July 1, 2011 (the "Effective Date").
