MINUTES OF THE GRAND RAPIDS-KENT COUNTY CONVENTION/ARENA AUTHORITY BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING Wednesday, February 22, 2006

I. Call to Order

Chairman Steve Heacock called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. Chairman Heacock presided and Secretary/Treasurer Birgit Klohs recorded. Chairman Heacock added Diversity Initiative as new agenda item VI.

II. Minutes of Prior Meeting

Motion: Mr. McInerney, supported by Mr. Heartwell, moved to approve the Minutes of the January 25, 2006, meeting of the Authority. Motion carried unanimously.

III. Committee Reports

- a. Operations Committee. The Operations Committee did not meet in February.
 - i. CVB Update

Mr. Wilson stated that DeVos Place® prevailed over four other venues competing for the Religious Conference Management Association convention in 2009. The CVB is working on a variety of conventions from environmental writers to the League of United Latin American Citizens. January was a very busy month, as evidenced by a 16% increase in hotel tax revenues over January 2005.

b. Finance Committee

i. SMG January 2006 Financial Statements for DeVos Place® and Van Andel Arena®

Motion: Ms. Klohs, supported by Mr. Charles, moved to approve the SMG Financial Statements for DeVos Place® and the Van Andel Arena® for the period ended January 31, 2006. After review and discussion, the motion was unanimously adopted.

ii. CAA January 2006 Disbursements and Financial Statements

Motion: Ms. Klohs, supported by Mr. McInerney, moved to approve the CAA Disbursements and Financial Statements for the period ended January 31, 2006. After review and discussion, the motion was unanimously adopted.

iii. CAA Audited Financial Statements

Ms. Klohs presented the audited financial statements with opinion by PricewaterhouseCoopers for the years ended June 30, 2003 and 2002. Ms. Klohs explained that the statements were delayed due to staff changes at the City, County, and PricewaterhouseCoopers. The Finance Committee has reviewed the audit and it is clean. The 2004 and 2005 audits should be completed by fall and the 2006 audit should be completed by year's end.

iv. Capital Outlay Report

Ms. Klohs presented an update on the capital outlay budget. Ms. Klohs acknowledged Grand Action for its gift of \$38,170 to reimburse the CAA for the glow-in-the-dark stair nosings in DeVos Performance Hall. Grand Action will also contribute \$90,000 towards the DeVos Performance Hall hearing loop system.

IV. Report from Food Service Contacting Subcommittee

Mr. Tomaselli reported that the concession contact with Centerplate expires June 30, 2006 and the CAA has engaged Bigelow Companies, Inc. to conduct an analysis of the current agreement and make recommendations. Chairman Heacock set up a subcommittee including himself, Lew Chamberlin, Joe Tomaselli, Richard Wendt, and Robert White to work with the principal consultant, Chris Bigelow. SMG has expressed an interest in bidding on the contract and invited subcommittee members to observe its Oklahoma City operations. Chairman Heacock also met with officials from Centerplate, who expressed a keen interest in retaining the account and will provide a creative proposal in terms of capital. The subcommittee will be meeting with Chris Bigelow in March and would like to have a recommendation for the Board in April.

V. Chairman's Comments

Chairman Heacock opened his 2006 annual report recounting the many diverse activities held at DeVos Place® and the Van Andel Arena® during the past year. The Steelcase Ballroom was dedicated on February 1, 2005; the Michigan Landscape Nursery Association brought 7,000 delegates to town and the Wesleyan Church brought 3,000 BACK for a youth conference because their annual national conference held here in 2004 went so well. Stock cars were racing in the exhibit halls at the same time that people dined in the ballroom. More than 630,000 people passed through the turnstyles at the Van Andel Arena® in 2005, enjoying such a wide range of events as MSU basketball, Disney of Ice, monster truck, rock concerts, and graduation commencements.

Mr. Heacock reported on the outcome of the 2005 initiatives, which included review of the booking policy, long-term capital plan, CAA relationship with City and County, and CAA accessibility. For the 2006 initiatives, 2006 will be the Year of Customer Service. Key initiatives would include: 1) a focus on exemplary customer service in each contract being renewed in 2006 (management, food service, security, etc.); 2) study of potential marketing fund and/or formal relationship with CVB; 3) review of governance and administration of CAA; 4) helping the City and private interest assure the future of the public museum; 5) examine regional impact/possible collaborations; and 6) getting art up in the convention center.

VI. Diversity Initiative

Mr. Charles presented an update on the diversity initiative that he, Chairman Heacock, and Rich MacKeigan worked on over the past year. They identified the two largest opportunities in terms of population and entertainment possibilities were in the African-American and Hispanic communities. The following goals were established:

1. Identify current programming at both facilities that would be viewed as "Diverse" or "Of Minority Appeal"

2. Identify programming we are not currently getting at our venues and attempt to do so

- While we have seen African American plays in DeVos, there were more of them playing in other markets that we felt we could have here as well. Tyler Perry was identified as a perfect fit. Mr. MacKeigan worked his contacts to initiate a dialogue with his representatives and he and his staff rolled out the red carpet for them during a visit last summer. They were impressed enough to give Van Andel Arena® a chance and we saw, by everyone's account, one of the most entertaining and uplifting nights since the Arena opened.
- Gospel Singers were another area identified for expansion. Kirk Franklin, a well known
 Gospel Singer, was identified. I am pleased to announce we will have Kirk Franklin and
 Mary Mary at Van Andel Arena® on April 28. This event was largely due to the success
 of the Tyler Perry show...it is true, success begets success.
- We have identified the Hispanic Market as the fastest growing market in West Michigan. Additionally, Rich feels this is a market that is underserved relative to entertainment, especially downtown. Rich has worked aggressively with promoters and potential sponsors to create a bilingual or completely Hispanic performance of Disney on Ice, Ringling Brothers, Barnum and Bailey Circus and/or World Toughest Rodeo Bulls and Broncs. We have seen interest on behalf of all and plans are underway to achieve this goal. In the interim, we have seen these promoters increase their awareness of, and outreach to, the Hispanic Market. Disney on Ice this year will focus a "Family Promotion" targeted exclusively at the Hispanic demo. Once proven, similar plans will be put in place for the Circus next September and SMG will continue to lobby Feld (the events' promoter) for an all Hispanic show. Also, the Bulls and Broncs event has printed 300 Spanish posters which will be part of a major multi-media effort in the Hispanic market.

3. Increase the diversity of our workforce at both buildings

- SMG has encouraged our contracted partners to aggressively market in minority targeted media in an effort to increase the minority representation of those working events. We have already seen efforts in this area from a number of them and are pleased with plans for further development.
- SMG will focus their efforts regarding full time hires to encourage a diversified workforce. While there is some diversity currently, it is not representative of our community at all levels.

4. Reach out to leaders and "opinion formers" in the minority communities

- We have seen tremendous strides in this area. We have informally set up a relationship with the Inter Denominational Ministerial Alliance (IDMA). We will look to formalize this over the next twelve months, as well as grow this to include members of the African American business community. The Reverend Nathaniel Moody deserves a great amount of credit for providing leadership in this regard.
- SMG is finalizing plans to become a partner with the Hispanic Chamber of Commerce, which will include DeVos Place's hosting of the Chamber's annual Showcase during 2006 and other cross promotional opportunities.
- SMG is getting more and more involved in the Grand Rapids Chamber of Commerce's Diversity program and will continue to do so.

5. Find a way (if possible) to track our progress with quantifiable results

• Rich has had a couple of meetings with Diversity Management Strategies, a company that may be able to assess our current position and assist in strategies towards increased diversity. They have provided a proposal, at our request, which we are in the process of reviewing. Rich and Clif plan to meet with them over the next four weeks to assess whether this is something we would recommend the CAA pursue.

VII. SMG Report and Facilities Calendar

Mr. MacKeigan presented an update on the upcoming concerts and shows that will be held this season at DeVos Place® and the Van Andel Arena®. The Van Andel Arena® will play host to the U.S. Synchronized Skating Championships, World's Toughest Bulls & Broncs, Griffins hockey, Rampage football, and monster trucks. The public show season continues over at DeVos Place® with the Home and Garden Show and Sport, Fishing & RV Show yet to come, the annual Taste of Chamber, Addie Awards, Grand Rapids Symphony, Joseph & the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat, and numerous trade shows.

EVENT INCOME

Event income came in higher than budget for the month. Most of the overage was in the Performance Hall with the addition of Blast to the schedule, and the very successful Jerry Seinfeld date.

ANCILLARY INCOME

Ancillary income was higher for the month. Overage was mainly due to higher than expected spending in decorating and audio/visual. In addition, the facility hosted more satellite events as an offshoot of other, larger events being hosted in the facility. These events are typically reception based, contributing to higher than expected food & beverage revenue.

INDIRECT EXPENSES

Indirect expenses came in higher than budget for the month, however, overall is still very consistent with expectations. The current month appears to be more a "timing of expenses" than any sort of sign of a negative trend.

INDIRECT EXPENSES

Indirect expenses came in higher than budget, mainly due to winter heating. Overall utilities are running about 10% over budget year to date. We anticipate some correction to this trend for the remainder of the fiscal year.

At the February 16, 2006, Finance Committee meeting, the audited financial report for Fiscal Years ended June 30, 2002 & 2003 was reviewed and accepted. Shortly thereafter, staff issued a "Request for Proposals" which solicited audit services for the Fiscal Years ending June 30, 2004 through 2006, inclusive.

On March 10, 2006, staff opened and read responses from all five-audit firms solicited in the original mailing. A bid tabulation is attached hereto. After having read the proposals submitted, it is the recommendation of staff that the Finance Committee recommend the designation of BDO Seidman LLP as auditor of the Convention/Arena Authority for the Fiscal Years ending June 30, 2004 through 2006. The fee quoted for these services totaled \$40,000 with an allowance of \$250 per annum for out of pocket expenses.

Assuming the concurrence of the Finance Committee and Board, staff would expect to deliver draft financial statements for the Fiscal Years ending June 30, 2004 and 2005 to the auditors in May 2006. Staff would expect to deliver the final audited financial statements, with auditor opinion, to the Finance Committee meeting of July 2006. It is expected that the draft financial statements for the year ending June 30, 2006 will be made available to the auditor in October 2006, with delivery of the final audited financial statements, with auditor opinion, delivered to the December 2006 Finance Committee meeting.

This memorandum and attached bid tabulation will be delivered to the Finance Committee meeting presently scheduled for Thursday, March 16, 2006.
