#### 2. Welcome & Introduction of New CAA Board Member

Chair Chamberlin welcomed and introduced Mike Verhulst, new CAA Board member. Mike is the Executive Vice President of Strategic Growth for Acrisure Benefits Group. Prior to this position, Mike served as Vice President of Rockford Construction for over four years, Vice President of Business Development and Community Relations for Wolverine Building Group for over three years, and President-Owner of Summit Landscape Management, Inc. for 16 years. Verhulst also serves on many community boards. Mike stated that he is excited to work with the CAA Board for the continued success of the venues.

#### 3. Minutes of March 30, 2022

#### 4. International Wine, Beer & Food Festival Preview

Dawn Baker announced that the 15th annual International Wine, Beer & Food Festival will be held Friday and Saturday, November 18 and 19. Mike Wilbraham provided an economic update, stating that attendance is expected to be strong based on other ShowSpan public shows this season. There will be a slight decrease in the number of exhibitors, as they are struggling with staffing and volunteers. The Festival has been recognized by Forbes as one of the "best fall wine festivals in North America you want to miss," and by Best Things Michigan as one of "the 8 best fall festivals in Michigan." Community endeavors include the Meijer supplier diversity sponsorship, People First & DGRI collaboration, four beer companies from Sister City Zapopan, Mexico, and collaboration with Experience GR for restaurant week. Volunteers are the backbone of the Festival and are now referred to as Festival Ambassadors. Over \$60,000 given annually to local universities, school groups, and nonprofits for their volunteer services. New presenters will be featured on the Meijer Food Stage: Chef Trimmel Hawkins, Gina Ferwerda, Chef Jeff Gordon, and a chef from Michigan Great, Michigan Grown. Because of Covid protocols, tasting sessions were excluded last year but will be back. More musicians and more performance times are scheduled throughout the Festival. Digital ticketing is here to stay, as it is easy, accurate, and saves on staffing. The Festival has a strong social media presence on Facebook, Instagram, and TikTok.

#### 5. ASM Global Operations Report

Mr. Tadlock presented an update on operations at the venues. The Arena basketball court was refinished in September. The court was stripped to bare wood, sealed, painted, and coated. Staff is working with a select number of venue security directors and managers, as well as the corporate VP of security, on the creation of a Risk Assessment/Threat level tool that will be used for all events during the booking process. Roll out is estimated at the beginning of 2023. As part of the VenueShield program, ASM Global and Clorox have created a partnership to make Clorox the preferred supplier of several disinfection products. ASM Grand Rapids was part a group of Tier 1 venues chosen to roll out the program. Products provided by Clorox (and still procured from a local vendor) include 360 disinfecting spray, hand sanitizer stations, and disinfecting wipes. Staff at the Arena are getting ready for hockey and basketball season. Ice was made for the hockey season this week. Scoreboard upgrades are in process to include basketball scoring features and GR Gold representation. The DeVos Place® parking ramp has been re-striped and staff is working on a skywalk wayfinding system. DeVos Place® hosted 49 artists during ArtPrize and boasts five winners in the following categories: artist to artist; visitor favorite; Artiste Latina; juried award; and Asian art award.

# 6. **Report from Experience Grand Rapids**

Ms. Manier provided an overview of the CVB's sales activities and marketing efforts for September 2022. Sales team was on the road and attended client events and meetings in Detroit and Washington, D.C. Staff hosted 10 Grand Rapids site tours and 18 planners from Washington, D.C., for the VIP Grand Experience Fam.
