Maximum size of poster: 22" x 28" any color (larger posters will be disqualified)

Posters must have name of school, teacher or advisor's name & cell number, and grade levels of students who worked on the poster, listed neatly on the BACK right corner of the poster. Entry form for each school/club to be completed by Teacher/Advisor.
