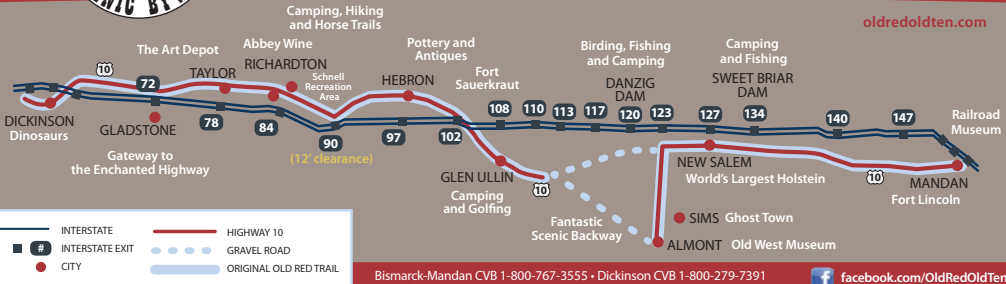

The recreation area side of the trail consists of a 1.9-mile concrete, 10 ft. wide path with unique fitness and play equipment stationed along the trail. The primitive side of the trail features a 6 ft. wide mowed grass trail along the south and west end of Patterson Lake with exceptional views and wildlife. This section of the trail is approximately 9.6 miles and runs through the Wildlife Management Area along the south side of Patterson Lake Recreation Area.

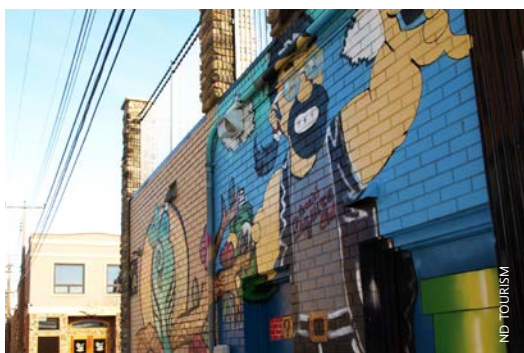


# Downtown DICKINSON

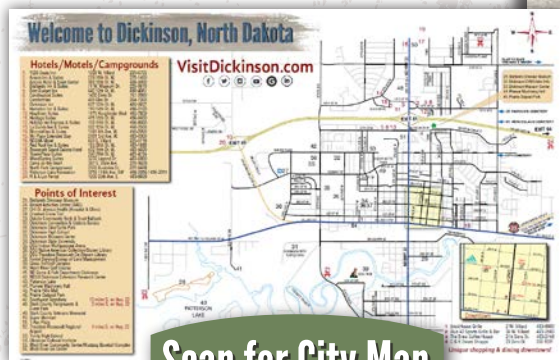
