When can I pick up my entries?

Exhibit Release:

All entries will be released and ready for pick up available on Sunday, August 6 between 5:00 & 6:00 p.m. in the Events Center. No early pick ups will be allowed. Go to each department to pick up your items. Remember to bring the stub from your exhibit tag or have your ID available.



How do I collect my premium winnings?

A table will be set up near the Creative Arts pick up area. Take your printout to the line and collect any ribbons and/or winnings due.



What if I'm unable to pick my up my entries when specified, or something comes up and I can't get them at the designated time?

Any unclaimed items will be held at the Fairgrounds Office, 500 Fairgrounds Road, Castle Rock, until Thursday, August 31. After Thursday, August 31, 2023, any unclaimed exhibits will be disposed of and any unclaimed premium money will be forfeited and returned to the General Fund of the Douglas County Fair & Rodeo.

Can I have someone else pick up my entries?

Yes, they just need to bring in the entry tag stub. You may have another person bring in your items on Entry day as well. You do not have to be present to enter.

Check-In procedure:

Entry forms are available on Entry day (our Open Class team will be here to assist you) and prior to Entry day at the Fairgrounds office office and the CSU Extension office (across the street from the Douglas County Events Center.)

Fill out the 2-part entry form. Take it to the Entry table where staff will enter your data into the software system and designate an Exhibitor Number for the 2-part form and the manila tag(s) - the tag with the string. They will return the yellow copy of the 2-part form to you. There will be team members available to answer questions.

2 Upon completion of your 2-part entry form and manila tags, you will take your exhibit items to each department. Give the item with its completed manila tag, and the yellow entry form, to the Superintendent at each department for check-in. The Superintendent will then return the stub portion of the exhibit tag and your yellow 2-part entry form to you.

Hold onto these items, as you will need them when you pick up your exhibit(s) on Release Day - Sunday, August 6, 2023 from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

When are entries judged?

Creative Arts entries will be judged on Monday, July 31, 2023.

Can I watch the judging?

Quilt judging is open to the public in the Events Center starting at 9:00 a.m. on **Monday, July 31, 2023** & will conclude when all quilts have been judged.

All other Creative Arts Departments are closed to the public during judging.

Where can I see my entry on display and is there a fee to see it?

All of the Open Division Creative Arts Department entries will be housed in the Events Center (a.k.a. the Marketplace). To view all exhibits displayed there, a general admission ticket will be required Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Creative Arts entrants will receive one wristband for free Fair entry to view the Creative Arts exhibits during Events Center open hours.
