Staff Report:

The small animal scale was delivered, the Fairgrounds is working with a small group of individuals on the best placement of the scale and with the CSU Extension Office to determine needs for use.

Competition Rules:

The General rules for both Creative Arts and Jr. Division were adjusted to match.

- 1) The following was added to: Section 1 → II. General Competition Rules → K. *All Junior Division Exhibitors must report to their barns for clean-up on Sunday at 4 pm.*
- 2) The following was added to: Section 2B → II. Competition Rules → I. Possession, Care and Showing → 7. *Junior Division Exhibitors may receive assistance from immediate family members or other Junior Division Exhibitors in good standing. An immediate family member is defined as the Junior Division Exhibitor's siblings, parents and/or legal guardian. Or other persons approved in advance by three members minimum of the Douglas County Fair & Rodeo Management.*
- 3) The following was added to: Beef → III. Animal Fitting and Care → B. → 1. *Absolutely no fitting products of any kind may be used. → 2. Animal can only be washed, dried and groomed for their show.*
- 4) The following was removed from the General Rules and added to: Sheep → III. Animal Fitting and Care → F, Market Goat → III. Animal Fitting and Care → B,

and Non-Market Dairy, Pygmy, Fiber & Utility Goat → III. Animal Fitting and Care → B:

B or F. Changing the color of hair at any point, spot or area on the animal's body or any grooming material that allows color to be rubbed off from any animal will result in disqualification.

1. The natural color of any animal cannot be altered using any artificial coloring.

The question was brought up if a rule could be made that Junior Division Exhibitors for a specific department have to be present at clean up. The committee as a whole agreed that this is allowed. A rule was added to the Dog Department under Department Provisions to reflect this.

A section was added to Sec 2B → II → Y → 3 to allow for Breeding Beef to be released the evening after the show.
