Meeting

Hometown Rodeo

Stock fee – Due to the increase in Hometown Rodeo stock, the Committee discussed the increase needed to the “stock charge” for 2022. The recommendation made was to increase cattle stock charge from \$29.00 to \$40.00 and goat stock charge from \$8.00 to \$30.00. This recommendation will be taken to the Executive Committee then Fair Board for approval.

Revisions to the entry form – Some minor change requests to current form include-

- More space to write city
- Changed “Breakaway Roping 14 & up” to 2 lines “Breakaway Roping 14-19” and “Breakaway Roping 20 & up”
- Move “Cowhide Race” from bottom to below Daly Ribbon Roping.
- Change date for age from “7/20/22” to “7/1/22” per Hometown Rodeo Rules

Mutton Bustin’

Entry fee increase - Due to the increase in Hometown Rodeo stock, the Committee discussed the increase needed to the participation fee for 2022. The recommendation made was to increase from \$20.00 to \$25.00 This recommendation will be taken to the Executive Committee then Fair Board for approval.

PRCA Youth Camp

The Committee discussed the options with holding the PRCA camp during Fair. They decided on the following-

- Event to be August 6th, 2022
- Registration fee is \$20.00
- Limited to 40 kids ages 8yrs to 18yrs
- Registration and payment to be handled by Douglas County Fair Foundation
- Check-in at 10:30am (table outside westgate)
- Instruction/Speakers/Lunch from 11am to 12pm in Kirk Hall
- Outdoor Arena activities from 12:00pm to 3:00pm
- Event will be made up of 4 stations. 10 kids at each location for 45 minutes
- Lunch will be provided by local Dairy Queen

Budget

2023 budget requests are due in June. Coral provided John with budget form and a copy of last year's request. The Committee discussed needs and funds to carry on with the larger Rodeo for 2023. The suggestion of having the next meeting one week early to finalize the request was agreed on.
