### **MINUTES**

#### **Meeting**

2023 Budget – John, after speaking with Tim Hallmark, presented the Rodeo Committee with 2 budget requests. Priority one – funds to maintain the larger Rodeo. Priority two - funds for anticipated inflation. The Committee reviewed the requests and agreed to move forward with both.

Hometown Fees – Debbie speaking for the Foundation, did not think the \$1500 will be an issue and would mostly likely be covered by the Foundation donation. The Committee agreed an increase would still be needed. The new recommendation to be taken to Executive/ Fair Board will be to increase cattle stock charge from \$29 to \$35, goat from \$8 to \$15 and non-animal from \$4 to \$5. Additionally, Mutton Bustin' fee to increase from \$20 to \$25.

Hometown Drill Team Change – Blazing Saddles drill team will replace Sweethearts for Rodeo who is taking the year off.

PRCA Youth Camp- Debbie has received the flyer from the PRCA and the Foundation is working on setting up the registration link. Registration expected to go live June 15<sup>th</sup>. Coral requested the information to sent to her for the website and for an event planning worksheet.

Debbie & Scott are working on additional catering quotes

Debbie requested that someone on the Committee look over the Hometown Rodeo equipment to assure its ready to go on July 30<sup>th</sup>.
