Additional Added Money Discussion

John Adams opened the meeting at 6:30pm by thanking the committee for helping with the contestant dinner on Saturday night at the Stock Show. It was a great night.

John then moved the discussion into the additional budget the Rodeo committee was awarded in order to hold a larger rodeo for the 2022 Fair. His recommendation to the committee was to remove Thursday's extreme bull riding event and replace with a rough stock event. The purse money from the bull event would then apply to the Rodeo. The larger purse for the Rodeo would put our Rodeo in the Top 4 for our weekend. It was mentioned that the bull riding event is labor intensive for staff. There will be additional costs with a large rodeo other than purse money, such as better stock would be required from the stock contractor. The committee members in attendance all agreed on this change to event schedule. Debbie Mills mentioned the committee would need to come up with a name for the new event.

Luanne Lee asked to clarify the large rodeo requirements as there may be some miscommunication from PRCA.
