

2022 HAY SHOW RULES

(Revised July 2022)

1. Entries for the Hay Show must be produced in Smith County or by producers residing in Smith County.
2. An entry consists of **one small sack** (lunch bag size) full of hay. All entries become the property of the Hay Show Committee.
3. Hay can be entered August 4th - 6th at one of the following locations:
 - In Tyler: United Ag & Turf, Inc.; Red River Specialties; Lowe Tractor; USDA-SWCD Office; AgriLife Extension Office
 - In Bullard: Circle C Farm & Ranch
 - In Lindale: Fleming Farm Supply
 - In Noonday: Feed Store
 - In Troup: Steele's Feed & Seed
 - In Whitehouse: Whitehouse Farm & Ranch
 - In Flint: Noonday Feed Store

Official entry cards must be attached to each entry and will be available at each location listed above.

4. A \$3.00 fee per entry is to be paid at the time hay is entered and covers the lab analysis. Make checks payable to **Smith County SWCD**.
5. Judging of the hay will take place on August 9th.
6. Hay will be judged by chemical score as follows: % crude protein + (100 - % ADF) Example: 20% crude protein hay with 25% ADF = $20 + (100 - 25) = 95$ [Equation will be updated to reflect change to TDN]
7. Hay show results will be announced at the Howdy Neighbor Bar-B-Que on September 22nd at 5:00pm under the Community Stage Tent.
8. Blue, red, and white ribbons will be awarded.
