

2026 Ellis County Syndicate Scholarship

Scholarship Details and Eligibility

- Four \$2,500 scholarships available
- Must be a graduating Senior who is a member of a 4-H or FFA chapter in Ellis County
- Must have exhibited for at least 2 years in the Ellis County Youth Expo
- Scholarship money will be awarded when the student is enrolled in college and a copy of the tuition bill is submitted to the committee. Remaining money, if available, will be awarded the next semester following the same procedure.
- Scholarship money must be used by the 2nd Fall semester following High School graduation, or the money will be forfeited and returned to the scholarship fund.
- Scholarship recipients may use the scholarship at any junior or senior college/university, public, private, or technical.
- Applications must be postmarked no later than **April 10, 2026**.
- Scholarship recipients will be announced in May.
- Student must include a copy of their official High School Transcript, SAT and/or ACT scores.
- Student must include a typed narrative (no more than one page) describing why he or she should be chosen for the scholarship.
- 2 letters of recommendation must be submitted. Letters cannot be from family members.
