

THE ERIE COUNTY FAIR LIVESTOCK CAMPING REQUEST

Requests are due by Friday July 24, 2026 (Must Enter Online)

(4-H exhibitors, you will need to make an account and use this site as well. 4-H Horse camping use <https://ecfairhorse.fairwire.com>)

The Fee will be \$35 per night.
This fee is applicable to the Horse Lot as well as the
Lower Camping Lot on McKinley/Quinby Drive.
The following hook-ups are available:

Water & Electricity

There will not be sewer hook-ups, a pump service will be available

You will receive a notice following the deadline if your request is accepted as space is limited. We will ask you to respond with the following needed information.

- Length of your camper, hitch to bumper
- Width of your camper included slide outs
- Identifying brand of your camper
- License plate #
- The dates you plan to arrive, stay and depart.

We will move in any campers that plan to stay the entire fair or the beginning days of the fair on Saturday August 8, 2026. Those camping for the entire fair will be asked to arrive first so the camper lot is used efficiently. You will receive email correspondence to set up your time. If you cannot make the time assigned, other arrangements will need to be made during times available.

Campers must leave when animals leave the grounds, if not before.

**** Tents using electricity will also be charged****

Again, camper space availability is based on first-come, first-served basis!

Livestock Campground Guidelines

Camping requests: Requests are only accepted online. Once the camper lot has reached the maximum number of requests it will no longer be available online. Please call the office at (716) 649-3900 ext. 6499 for other arrangements. Spots are reserved on a first-come, first-served basis.

Arrival: Campers may arrive on Saturday August 8, 2026, at the time slot they are allotted. No campers will be allowed to park unless a campground committee member is present. At the time of your arrival, you will be given the campground rules. It is important for all families to follow this procedure so that camp spaces are used efficiently and safely. Failure to follow this procedure may result in the loss of your camping privileges at The Erie County Fair.

CAMPGROUND RULES:

At the discretion of the New York State Department of Health and in order to maintain our operating permit, the following regulations must be always implemented and adhered to.

1. A seven (7) foot separation between each unit/extremities MUST be maintained on all sides. This measurement is from the furthest extremity, slide out or other apparatus.
2. No bonfires/campfires
3. No open flames of any type, including propane grills, charcoal, cook stoves etc.
4. No awnings are allowed in the down position
5. Do NOT block the roadways with any personal vehicles
6. All fire lanes must be maintained at all times.
7. Speed limit is 5mph.
8. No gray water dumping is permitted in any lot. *(Scavenger services are available by visiting the main office and paying for a pump-out)*
9. Outside cooking is permitted in designated areas only and must be a minimum of twenty five (25) feet from any structure or unit.
10. ALL units MUST have a fire extinguisher or method of fire protection available.
11. Vehicles must have appropriate pass to be permitted in the RV Parking lot. Vehicles cannot park amongst campers they must be in a designated parking spot.
12. No alcoholic containers are allowed outside of the RV's.
13. Any child under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult at all times while in the RV Parking.
14. Quiet hours are 11pm-7am
15. All spaces MUST be pre-paid prior to arrival.

Failure to comply with these regulations will result in the loss of privileges and immediate removal of the unit.

****PUMP OUTS****

Gray Water Full? We Can Help!

1. All residents will be responsible to go to the Erie County Fair Main Office (Located behind Grandstands)- Agriculture and Competitive Exhibits Office to pay for pump-out service by 7:00 PM the night prior in order to be placed on the pump schedule for the following day. Requests not submitted by 7:00 PM will not be pumped.
2. When you come to the office you will need:
 - \$40 for the pump (cash, check or credit card)
 - Camper license plate number.
 - Brand of camper
3. The pump truck will only pump those that have paid and are on the list provided by the Erie County Fair Main Office.
4. Payment per pump is \$40.00 ***No pumps will be completed without payment!***
5. No payments will be accepted at the 4-H/Livestock gate. All payments *must* go through the Erie County Fair Main Office.
6. Horse lot campers will go to the Horse Show Office to pay for and reserve their pump.
