Llama/Alpaca RULES

- a) All Llama and Alpaca health records must accompany animals to the Fair. All llamas/alpacas must show proof of active immunization against rabies, and must be negative to an approved test appropriate to detect Bovine Viral Diarrhea persistent infection (BVD-PI).
- b) Llamas and Alpacas must be identified by a microchip that is to be used as positive identification on the official entry form and health papers. All animals must have been identified by June 1, 2024 through the submission of a Llama/Alpaca identification card listing microchip information to the 4-H office. (paperwork includes: Llama/Alpaca enrollment and Llama/Alpaca Lease agreement showing all registration information of the animal being leased)
- c) Exhibitors shall be neat and clean wearing dress shirt and dark pants or skirt, closed toe shoes.
- d) Breeding Animals MUST submit a copy of the registration form to the 4-H office by June 1, 2024.
- e) All participants must be 8 years old as of January 1, 2024. Youth 5-7 years old are cloverbuds and must have an adult side walker at all times.
- f) All exhibitors must have given a public presentation prior to May 2024.
- g) All exhibitors must participate in a livestock interview in July 2024
- h) All exhibitors must have participated in two (2) Erie County 4-H Llama/Alpaca educational meetings to be eligible to show at the fair.
- i) ALL exhibitors are responsible for maintaining their exhibit until released by the 4-H program on Sunday, August 18, 2024, failure to do so will result in not being able to participate at The Erie County Fair in the future and forfeit of premium checks. (See CCE regulations in your handbook)
