MARKET SWINE RULES

- a) All market swine must be owned and cared for by the exhibitor by May 1, 2024. All hogs must be born on or after January 1, 2024
- b) All swine health records must accompany animals to the Fair.
- c) Swine must possess an official USDA ear tag. (21 tag, Premise ID tag or an 840 RFID)
- d) All market animals must have been identified on the swine registration card and submitted to 4-H office by May 1, 2024 with proper photo ID.
- e) Boars may not be shown in the Market Show. In those cases where the pig is discovered to be a boar after it has been sold and slaughtered, the participant will forfeit the sale price of the swine by returning the purchase price in full to the buyer of said swine.
- f) If at any time an entered swine is found to be a boar before the sale, the entered swine MUST be removed from the fairgrounds immediately.
- g) Market Swine participants must be 9 years old as of January 1, 2024.
- h) Market Swine classes will be grouped into Light Weight, Medium Weight and Heavy Weight divisions with breaks being determined after official weigh in. The Champion Drive will consist of the Champion and Reserve Champion Hog from the Light, Medium and Heavy weight divisions and the judge will have the discretion to request a 3rd or 4th place hog from a division to enter the ring in the final drive.
- i) Sale market hogs must be used for showmanship.
- j) Market hogs will be sold on Saturday, August 17, 2024 at 11:30 AM, ALL exhibitors are responsible for maintaining their exhibits until released by the 4-H program on Sunday, August 18, 2024. Failure to do so will result in not being able to participate at The Erie County Fair in the future and forfeit of premium checks. (See CCE regulations in your handbook)
- k) All exhibitors are eligible to bring 2 market hogs to the fair in 2024. Both hogs must meet the required weight of 220-290. Youth may show both hogs in the market show but will be able to sell only their highest placing animal in the sale. The second animal must return home with the member on Sunday, August 18, 2024.
- All exhibitors selling a market animal in the auction are required to attend at least 2 Marketing Workshops (held January-March) and at least2 Erie County 4-H meetings, one being species specific, participated in Public Presentations prior to may 2024, and Livestock interview in July to be eligible to sell.

NON-SALE MARKET SWINE RULES:

*There is no class number for this section, all hogs will be signed up through class #5: Project Market Swine

Market hogs of exhibitors that do not make the sale weights of 220-290 pounds at the time of weigh-in will be eligible to stay at the fair to be shown in showmanship and a non-sale class provided:

- a) Exhibitors must meet all program requirements
- b) They must weigh 210-219 to be eligible for the non-sale light weight class or 291-300 to be eligible for the non-sale heavy weight class and are not eligible to compete in the Championship drive.
- c) Member will participate in the appropriate Showmanship class with other members.
- d) This market hog is not eligible to be sold through the 4-H/FFA Market Auction.
- e) Members may not post "for sale" signs on pens of non-sale market hogs.
- f) Hogs qualifying for the non-sale class must be removed from the fairgrounds by the exhibitor on Sunday, August 18, 2024 at 6:00pm, per release ticket.
- g) Non-sale market hogs are NOT eligible for transportation to a processor on a 4-H hired trailer.
- h) This opportunity has been put in place to educate members and parents for a positive outcome the following year.

BREEDING SWINE RULES

- a) All registered animals must have a current valid registration paper with animal being owned by the exhibitor by May 1, 2024
- b) All commercial animals must have a 4-H breeding Swine Registration Card on file in the 4-H office as of May 1, 2024 with ear tag information.
- c) Animals exhibited in the breeding swine section may not have been exhibited as a market animal and cannot have been sold through 4-H/FFA auction
- d) Registration papers MUST be presented at check-in at the fair (official registration paper must be provided).
- e) The breeding swine program is open to all youth that are 5 years and older as of January 1, 2024.
- f) All breeding swine participants are required to participate in a livestock interview and at least 2 4-H meetings.
- g) CLOVERBUDS (5-7 years old) are eligible for showmanship and breeding classes, but will not compete in any champion classes.

Receipt should state the animal was born after January 1, 2022, that the sow was bred and farrowed in New York State. Open only to sale market hogs. Placings will be determined in the market hog classes, exhibitors with a NYBBR hog will have a colored sticker on your show number.

Class #27 – Swine Educational Poster – Participants shall construct an educational poster to educate the general public about an aspect of the swine industry. Exhibitors may use any suitable materials or photographs on their posters with accurate information. Posters will be evaluated on content, illustration, organization, clarity, visual appeal and readability.
