#### **General Afghan Rules**

- 1. Please read and abide by all The Erie County Fair and Creative Arts Department rules and regulations. This document includes details new to 2021!
- 2. All entries must be pre-registered by Friday July 16, 2021. Entries not pre-registered will not be accepted. For more information see the Rules and Regulations.
- 3. Afghans must have been made by the exhibitor.
- 4. Only Afghans, which are free from soil and stain, will be judged.
- 5. Each entry will be judged on its own merit.
- Size requirements: Minimum size: 40" x 60" excluding fringe Maximum size: 63" x 86" excluding fringe
- 7. All entries must be clean and free of dirt, pet hair and stains.

Add a "Creator's Note" to your entry. When dropping your entry off include a one sided 5"x8" index card that contains:

1. Name of Project

- 2. How many "sweat equity hours" the project took to complete
- 3. Cost of materials
- 4. Story: Please share a story associated with this project.
- 5. Is this item available for purchase? No prices to be listed, only contact info.
- This card is to be filled out in advance and will be attached to the entry ticket for fair patrons to read.

## Judging Criteria

- 1. Afghans must be clean and free from odor from pets and smoking.
- 2. Sizes must adhere to the General Afghan rule #6.
- 3. Color must be harmonious and pleasant to the eye. No variation in color due to mixing of dye dots.
- 4. Pattern and Design, the more challenging the pattern the better. Loose stitching is not acceptable.
- 5. Finishing- There should be no knots, loose yarn tails, the afghans should be blocked.
- 6. Each entry will be judged on its own merit.
