ENTRY DEADLINE: FRIDAY, JULY 12th, 2024

Entry Fee: \$25.00 allows entries throughout the Erie County Fair. A promo code redeemable for three (3) admission passes will be emailed to the exhibitor on Tuesday, July 30th.

Entry Arrival: Tuesday, July 23rd, or Wednesday, July 24th between NOON and 8PM

Entry Removal: Wednesday, August 21st or Thursday, August 22nd between 11:00 AM – 7:00 PM

Prize Checks: Available Tuesday, August 13th – Sunday, August 18th between 11:00 AM – 10:00 PM at the Creative Arts Info Desk along with satin ribbons earned. Checks remaining after this time will be mailed.

General Crocheting Rules

1. Please read and abide by The Erie County Fair and Creative Arts Department rules and regulations.
2. All entries must be pre-registered by Friday, July 12th, 2024. Entries not pre-registered will not be accepted. For more information see the Important Entry Information page.
3. Articles will be judged on the following: overall appearance, design, harmony of color, workmanship, quality of materials used (no loose ends on the inside of the garment), finishing and originality.
4. Condition of the article must be clean, **properly blocked** and not noticeably worn. **Soiled articles will not be judged.** Articles are to be the work of the exhibitor.
5. **PLEASE NOTE: In describing categories: An article with a contrasting design refers to a color design. An article with pattern stitch refers to a design in the stitch itself such as lace, cables, basket stitch, etc. Unless otherwise indicated, articles may be either hand knitted or crocheted.**
6. All entries must be clean and free of dirt, pet hair and stains.
7. Please - no name labels.

WOMEN'S CLOTHING - 1

1. Pullover Sweater (Pattern Stitch)
2. Cardigan Sweater (Contrasting Design)
3. Cardigan Sweater (Pattern Design)
4. Casual Shirt (tank, halter, or hooded sweatshirt, etc.)
5. Vest (casual or dress, etc.)
6. Sleepwear (pajamas, lounge, slip or robe, etc.)
7. Holiday Clothing (Christmas, Valentine's, etc.)
8. Coat/ Jacket

MEN'S CLOTHING - 2

1. Holiday Clothing (Christmas, Valentine's, etc.)
2. Sports Themed Clothing

CHILDREN'S CLOTHING - 3

1. Christening Outfit (dress or suit)
2. Dress Short Length (casual, jumper, drop-waist, sundress, or pillow dress, etc.)
3. Skirt/Skort (all lengths and styles)
