ENTRY DEADLINE: FRIDAY JULY 16, 2021

- Entry Fee:** \$15 fee allows for unlimited entries throughout department (unless otherwise specifically noted). Fee includes one (1) promo code for an admission ticket to the fair, parking included.
- Entry Arrival:** Tuesday, July 27th between 12:00 Noon and 6:00 PM, Wednesday, July 28th between 12:00 Noon and 6:00 PM OR Thursday, July 29th between 12:00 Noon and 8:00 PM
- Entry Removal:** Tuesday, August 24th between 11:00 AM – 7:00 PM
- Prize Checks:** Tuesday, August 17th – Sunday, August 22nd between 11:00 AM – 10:00 PM

General Crocheting Rules

1. Please read and abide by The Erie County Fair and Creative Arts Department rules and regulations.
2. All entries must be pre-registered by Friday July 16, 2021. Entries not pre-registered will not be accepted. For more information see the Important Entry Information page.
3. Articles will be judged on the following: overall appearance, design, harmony of color, workmanship, quality of materials used (no loose ends on the inside of the garment), finishing and originality.
4. Condition of the article must be clean, **properly blocked** and not noticeably worn. **Soiled articles will not be judged.** Articles are to be the work of the exhibitor.
5. PLEASE NOTE: In describing categories: An article with a **contrasting design** refers to a color design. An article with **pattern stitch** refers to a design in the stitch itself such as lace, cables, basket stitch, etc. Unless otherwise indicated, articles may be either hand knitted or crocheted.
6. All entries must be clean and free of dirt, pet hair and stains.
7. Please - no name labels.

Add a "Creator's Note" to your entry. When dropping your entry off include a one sided 5"x8" index card that contains:

1. Name of Project
2. How many "sweat equity hours" the project took to complete
3. Cost of materials
4. Story: Please share a story associated with this project.
5. Is this item available for purchase? No prices to be listed, only contact info.

This card is to be filled out in advance and will be attached to the entry ticket for fair patrons to read.
