General Rug Exhibit Rules

1. Size requirements:

Minimum size: 24" x 36" Maximum size: 48" x 60"

Rugs Judging Criteria:

- 1. Rugs should be clean and not noticeably worn. They should also be free of odor.
- 2. Pattern or Design the more challenging the pattern the better.
- 3. Stitches must be even and uniform. Sloppy or loose stitching or braiding is not acceptable. Color should be matching and pleasant to the eye.
- 4. Rugs are judged on the finishing and back as well. There should not be any knots or loose ends showing. All rugs should be bound and finished off.
- 5. Each rug will be judged on its own merit.

1. Traditional Hooked Wool Rug (other than latch hook)

Premiums for Rugs Classes # 2 - 8 Blue-\$7.00 Red-\$5.00
