Some exhibits may be placed on behalf of the Fairgrounds or other history related agencies and are not eligible for awards.

EXHIBIT AWARDS

Exhibits using the Fair Theme are encouraged, but not required.

The Erie County Agricultural Society has approved the following premiums:

1 st Prize	\$200.00
2 nd Prize	\$180.00
3 rd Prize	\$160.00
4 th Prize	\$140.00
5 th Prize	\$120.00
Participants, each	\$100.00
Theme Award	\$250.00

*The theme award is judged independently. This award is given to the Society who, in the opinion of the judges, has followed most closely the Erie County Fair theme.

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING EXHIBITS

Points are awarded on the basis of the following criteria:

1. ACCURACY AND CONTENT.

The topic of the exhibit should be appropriate to the history of the locality or mission statement of the Society. 25 points

2. PRESENTATION.

The exhibit should communicate a complete and well-organized story. 25 points

3. CREATIVE ABILITY.

A well-designed exhibit should show imaginative and appropriate use of materials. 25 points

4. MECHANICS.

Emphasis is placed on neatness of construction and legible labeling. 25 points
