Horse Show Camping Rules & Regulations

Pumpouts-\$40.00

At the direction of the New York State Department of Health and to maintain our operating permit, the following regulations must be always implemented and adhered to.

- All camper spaces include electric & water hookups. Space will be accommodated in the Horse Show Camper Lot (For trailers in this area all tow vehicles MUST be removed). Empty Trailer Parking NOT allowed in this area.
- Spaces will be allocated in the order the payment is received. Campers without prior approval will not be permitted in the camper area. NO TENTS. Any changes must be approved by the Horse Show Manager. Horse trailers, passenger vehicles, vans without factory installed living quarters, etc. will NOT be allowed in camper areas. In the event sufficient camper parking is not available in the stabling area, management reserves the right to assign campers to another area on the grounds. Campers are FIRST COME FIRST SERVE, and MUST be prepaid.
- NO gray water dumping! All residents will be responsible to go to the Horse Show Office to pay for a pump by 5:00PM the night before to get on the pump schedule for the next day. If not signed up by 5PM the night previous, you will NOT get pumped. The pump truck will only pump those that have paid and are on the list provided. <u>Payment per pump is \$40.00</u> and must be paid by CASH or CHECK. No pumps will be completed without payment and camper model and plate number.
- ALL attendees MUST have appropriate fair passes for each day of attendance while in the camper lot. Additional Exhibitor passes are available in the horse show office.
- A seven (7) foot separation between each unit/extremity MUST be maintained on all sides. This measurement is from the furthest extremity, slide out or other apparatus.
- No bonfires/campfires.
- No open flames of any type, including propane grills, charcoal, cook stoves etc.
- No awnings are allowed in the down position.
- NO dogs are allowed.
- Do NOT block the roadways with any personal vehicles.
- All fire lanes must be always maintained.
- Speed limit is 5mph.
- ALL units MUST have a fire extinguisher or method of fire protection available.
- No alcoholic containers are allowed outside of the RV's.
- Any child under the age of 18 must always be accompanied by an adult while in the RV Parking.
- Quiet Hours are 11pm-7am.
- Failure to display appropriate camper & vehicle parking permits will leave vehicles subject to tow. If room is available each camper will receive a vehicle permit. Vehicles must be housed in YOUR camper space. Vehicles taking up neighboring spaces will be subject to tow if space is not left clear for neighboring camper arrivals.
- All Spaces MUST be pre-paid through the ShoWorks entry system prior to arrival.

Failure to comply with regulations will result in the loss of privileges and immediate removal of unit.

Erie County Fair, RV Manager, Security and Horse Show Management reserves the right to remove any camper, vehicle or attendants at any time for any reason. BE RESPECTFUL!
