

# **Hunter Division:**

## **Low Hunter Section**

Open to all Riders, and horses/ponies in their first or second year of showing. Fence Height 2'-2'3"

## **Special Hunter Section**

Open to all riders and horses/ponies. Fence height 2'6"-2'9"

## **Low Child/Adult**

Open to all age non-pro riders. Fence Height 2'-2'3"

## **Child/Adult**

Open to all non-pro riders. Fence height 2'6"-2'9"

## **Pleasure Division**

Open to all riders and horses / ponies

## **Walk Trot Division**

Open to all riders, cannot ride in ANY loping classes

## **Long Stirrup Cross Rails Section**

Open to all age non pro rider. Fences Cross Rails

## **Short Stirrup Hunter Section**

Open to all age non pro rider. Fence heights verticals less than 2'

## **\$200 Erie County Open Hunter Derby**

Open to all. Fence height 2'-2'3"

A two-round competition. Scores from both rounds added together to determine the winners.

## **\$300 Erie County Open Hunter Derby**

Open to all. Fence height 2'6"

A two-round competition. Scores from both rounds added together to determine the winners.

## **\$500 Erie County Fair Child-Adult Hunter Derby**

Open to all non-pro riders. Fence height 2'9"

A two-round competition. Scores from both rounds added together to determine the winners.

# Jumper Division

## **Blue Ribbon Jumper**

Open to all. Open all day at all heights

## **Schooling Jumper**

Open to all age riders. Fence heights 2'-2'3"

## **Puddle Jumper**

Open to all. Fence height 2'6"

## **Training Jumper**

Open to all. Fence height 3'

## **\$500 Erie County Fair Team Challenge**

Open to all. Fence height 2'6"-3'0"

The Erie County Fair Horse Show Team Challenge is open to all that have shown in at least one jumper class at the ECF Horse Show this year. This is a team competition. There may be 3 or 4 members on each team. Each horse and rider combination will jump ONE ROUND. The best 3 scores, jumping faults and time faults, on each team will be added together to determine an overall score. Time taken on course will not be part of the first-round score, however, time faults will count. If there is a tie for first place, there will be a jump off to break that tie. In the jump off jumping faults and time taken on course will be added together to determine the total score. All ties for other than first place will have the tie broken by the combined times in the first round. There will be an order of go for the first round and the jump off, if needed.

**Team challenge entry must be made by ONE exhibitor, payouts will be sent to the exhibitor making the entry and that exhibitor can then split the prize money between the team.**

## **\$500 Erie County Fair Gambler's Choice**

Open to all. Fence height 2'6" - 2'9" Joker 3'3"

In this competition each fence will have a specific point value. Each competitor will have 60 seconds to accumulate as many points as possible. Each fence can be jumped only twice from either direction. At the end of 60 seconds a tone will sound, and the rider must go through the timers to establish their time. Their score and time will be announced and then another tone will sound. The rider will have 20 seconds to jump the joker fence. The joker will have a point value of 200. However, if the joker is knocked down the 200 points will be deducted from the riders score. Riders will have just one attempt to jump the joker fence. *A rider may elect to not attempt the joker with no penalty.* Time will break ties for those that accumulate the same point total. Refusals are not penalized.
