#### **General Junior Arts & Crafts Rules**

1. Please read and abide by The Erie County Fair and Creative Arts Department rules and regulations.

- 2. All entries must be pre-registered by Friday, July 12<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Entries not pre-registered will not be accepted. For more information see the Important Entry Information page.
- 3. This section is open to exhibitors ages 5 17.
- 4. One entry per class per exhibitor.
- 5. A junior exhibitor is limited to a total of two (2) entries in Junior Arts & Crafts.
- 6. No entry exceeding in overall size of 36" x 36" will be accepted unless otherwise specified.
- 7. Note: Size restraints in some classes.
- 8. An exhibitor 13 & older must purchase a \$25.00 exhibitor ticket, which includes three admissions to the Fair **OR** if ages 5-12 must pay \$5 junior entry fee (no passes to the Fair as ALL KIDS 12 & younger are FREE at the Fair).
- 9. Items will be displayed as space allows and at the discretion of the Superintendent.
- 10. NO items that are soiled will be accepted.
- 11. All work must have been done by the exhibitor within the last five (5) years.
- 12. To note, the Fair accepts artwork from all individuals, regardless of ability. The category of "Special Children of the Fair" no longer exists. The Fair is an integrated and all-inclusive event and the exhibits exemplify this.

#### Junior Section Judging Criteria:

- -Cleanliness (Free from dirt & stains)
- -Originality of items
- -Workmanship (ex: needlework-uniformity of stitches, sewing-placement of seams, painting- edges and backs finished, no drips from paint, beading- beads in item should be tight or firm, glued items- no visible glue showing)
- How items are finished (ex: are the back and sides finished? Is the item secure for hanging?)

#### **ARTS & CRAFTS - 1**

- 1. Calligraphy or rubber stamp art on fabric or wood not to exceed 12"x14"
- 2. Paper cutting (can include rubber stamping); picture (not to exceed 8" x 10"), handmade card, handmade bookmark, handmade stationary, handmade ornament
- 3. Item made with Fair theme, within the last 5 year
- 4. Mobile not to exceed 12" in diameter x 24" in length
- 5. Original designed item that is used as a decoration or for practical use. Made from recyclable material (ex. Paper, plastic or metal)
- 6. Origami not to exceed 12" x 12"
- 7. Real or faux stained glass sun catcher, leaded stained glass, picture frame, ornament not to exceed 8" x 10" all items must be original design
- 8. Decorated flip flop (use you own ideas)
- 9. Any item made from plastic canvas
- 10. Handmade jewelry
- 11. Christmas tree ornament or decoration, one
- 12. Christmas Items & Holiday Baskets
- 13. Hand painted or rubber stamped shirt (original design)
- 14. Doll, one handmade
- 15. Stuffed toy
- 16. Paint by Diamonds- from a kit
- 17. Paint by Diamonds- original or freestyle design

- 18. Hand Painted Item
- 19. Leatherwork, carved or stamp not to exceed 12"x 12" except for belts
- 20. Article, metal

The goal is to use all the items in the bucket (but not the bucket). The projects will be displayed inside.

#### **Bucket of Junk Contest Rules**

- 1. Please read and abide by all The Erie County Fair and Creative Arts Department rules and regulations.
- 2. Entries not pre-registered will not be accepted. For more information see the Important Entry Information page.
- 3. There will be ten (10) bucket of junk reservations available starting when online entries open. The first 10 reservations will be informed by e-mail when they can pick up their buckets. Please register online early, reservations go fast!
- 4. If for any reason, you will not be completing the contest, please return the bucket and items inside as soon as possible as it allows another exhibitor a chance.
- Creations are to be brought to the Creative Arts Exhibit Area (lower grandstand) on the Fairgrounds on Tuesday, July 23<sup>rd</sup> or Wednesday, July 24<sup>th</sup> between Noon and 8pm.
- 6. When you bring your creation to the Fairgrounds, please bring back the empty bucket.
- 7. If after receiving the items, you realize you will not be able to complete the project, please bring the items back to the office and we will contact the next person on the waiting list. Not returning the items or not bring the completed project could result in not being able to enter this project in the future

#### **Lego® Model Contest Rules**

- 1. Please read and abide by all The Erie County Fair and Creative Arts Department rules and regulations.
- 2. All entries must be pre-registered by Friday, July 12<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Entries not pre-registered will not be accepted. For more information see the Important Entry Information page.
- 3. One entry per exhibitor.
- 4. There will be a limit of twenty (20) entries PER AGE GROUP.
- 5. All model sizes should be **no larger than 12" in length x 12" wide x 15" high.**
- 6. ALL entries MUST have a **BASE** that they are SECURED to.
- Sculptures are to be brought to the Creative Arts Exhibit Area (lower grandstand) on the Fairgrounds on Tuesday, July 23<sup>rd</sup> or Wednesday, July 24<sup>th</sup> between Noon and 8pm.
- 8. All models will be judged based on **ORIGINALITY**, detail, and design.
- 9. No store-bought kits are to be submitted. An exhibitor may use pieces from purchased kits, to create an original design.

#### The specifics -

We will provide a bag full of old fair ribbons. All the bags will include the <u>same number</u> of ribbons. The ribbons can be cut, sewn, painted, ripped, burned, or manipulated. You may not add additional ribbons. Create whatever you want with the ribbons in your bag. The ribbons may be made into a quilt, soft or hard sculpture, painting, mask, collage, or anything else! The projects **will** be displayed inside.

#### **Ribbon Revamp Contest Rules**

- 1. Please read and abide by all The Erie County Fair and Creative Arts Department rules and regulations.
- 2. *All entries must be pre-registered by Friday, July 12<sup>th</sup>* Entries not pre-registered will not be accepted. For more information see the Important Entry Information page at <a href="https://www.ecfair.org">www.ecfair.org</a>.
- 3. Anyone under 18 years old is eligible to enter this contest.
- 4. One reservation per family or household. The project may be the group effort of a family or household.
- 5. There will be ten (10) ribbon revamp reservations available. The first 10 reservations will be informed by email when they can pick up their bags.
- 6. Creations are to be brought to the Creative Arts Exhibit Area on the Fairgrounds.
- 7. Size requirements:
  - Entries May not exceed 30" in any direction.
  - Poster board is best, and white is the preferred color. If your art is on a stretched canvas or canvas board, it does not need a border.
- 8. Exhibitors are only allowed to enter the Ribbon Revamp contest once every two years. 2024 Ribbon Revamp exhibitors are currently ineligible for the 2025 Eric County Fair Ribbon Revamp Contest.
- 9. If after receiving the items, you realize you will not be able to complete the project, please bring items back to the office and we will contact the next person on the waiting list.
