General Needle Arts Rules

- 1. Please read and abide by all The Erie County Fair and Creative Arts Department rules and regulations.
- 2. All entries must be pre-registered by Friday, July 12th, 2024. Entries not pre-registered will not be accepted. For more information see the Important Entry Information page.
- 3. Only one (1) entry per class.
- 4. Important: Needle Art pictures <u>Must be well framed</u> and wired with flexible picture wire, fastened to screw eyes on wooden frames or sliding hangers on metal frames. (No saw tooth hangers permitted). All others will not be accepted.
- 5. All entries must be clean and free of dirt, pet hair and stains.
- 6. We are unable to facilitate projects that require any technological needs (electric plug access, etc.)
- 7. The following **will not be ACCEPTED**:
 - Plastic canvas medium
 - Hoop pictures
 - Grouped miniatures to form a minimum picture size
 - Machine embroidery
 - Each entry will be judged on its own merit.

Minimum size: 8" x 10" including frame; Must include wire on the back Maximum size: 24" x 30" including frame; Must include wire on the back

Judging Criteria for Needle Arts

- 1. General Appearance. Is it pleasing to the eye? Does it have balance? Is there harmony among the subjects stitched?
- 2. Is the workmanship (technique) correctly executed?
- 3. Did the designer take into consideration the difficulty of the piece and use the correct technique?
- 4. Is the piece clean of smudges and marks?
- 5. Does the framing or finishing of the piece compliment the work itself?
- 6. Each entry will be judged on its own merit.

COUNTED CROSS STITCH – WORKED FROM A GRAPH - 1

- 1. Beginner/1st piece using Aida cloth, any count
- 2. Using Aida cloth, any count
- 3. Using Linen, any count
- 4. Samplers (Must include the Alphabet)
- 5. Textured Specialty Stitches, on Linen or Aida cloth, using techniques such as Hardanger Motifs, Hemstitching, Pulled/Drawn work, Smyrna crosses etc. No purchased embellishments.
- 6. Hardanger Embroidery on Linen, Aida or Canvas using only traditional Hardanger motifs and designs. May include purchased embellishments if desired.
- 7. Embellished Stitches using Linen or Aida cloth using Textured stitches as well as Beading, Metallic Threads, Silk Ribbon, buttons and/or other purchased embellishments.
- 8. Crewel Embroidery

NEEDLEPOINT – WORKED FROM A GRAPH - ON CANVAS - 2

1. Canvas Work. Needlepoint using all other stitches or techniques

FABRIC NEEDLEWORK WALL HANGINGS (30" x 30" MAXIMUM SIZE) - 3

1. Worked in counted cross-stitch, crewel, embroidered or any other stitch technique, must have appropriate hardware for hanging.

NEEDLEWORK DOOR/WALL DECORATIONS - 4

1. Worked in counted cross-stitch, crewel, embroidered or any other stitch technique, must have appropriate hardware for hanging.

DECORATIVE NEEDLEWORK PILLOWS - 5

- 1. Needlepoint using tent stitch or textured stitches
- 2. Counted Cross Stitch
- 3. Smocked
- 4. Patchwork or Appliquéd
- 5. Crewel
- 6. Crewel using Silk/Cotton threads or Crewel Yarn
- 7. Any needlework not listed above

BABY NEEDS USING VARIOUS TECHNIQUES - 6

1. Linen or Aida – Cross Stitch only – FRAMED

2. Baby Bib – Cross Stitch Only

DECORATIVE NEEDLEWORK BELL PULLS - 7

Worked in any stitch technique. Must be hemmed and have appropriate hardware for hanging.

1. Mini Bell Pull: Maximum width 3", Maximum length 12"

2. Bell Pull: 3"-8" wide; Maximum length 24"

CHRISTMAS DECORATIVE NEEDLEWORK - 8

1. Christmas Stocking Linen or Aida, using any stitch technique

2. Christmas Tree Ornaments

DECORATIVE TABLE TOP ITEM - 9

- 1. Paperweights any technique
- 2. Boxes (porcelain, wooden, music or perforated paper) using any technique
- 3. Needlework Accessories (Needle cases, scissors fob or holder, pincushions, matched sets) Maximum 5 pieces accepted in this category only
- 4. Needlework trays any technique
- 5. Jewelry such as earring, bracelet, pendants using needlework

6. Jewelry such as earring, bracelet, pendants, amulet bag using only beads

PERFORATED PAPER USING ANY TECHNIQUE- GREETING CARDS - 10

1. Anniversary

- 2. Christmas
- 3. Any other occasion not listed above

CRAZY TECHNIQUE STITCHING - 11

1. Crazy Quilt Squares

SPECIAL CLASSES – No Size Minimum - 12

- 1. Black Work (Linen or Aida)
- 2. Needle Painting or Bunka Embroidery
- 3. Silk Ribbon Work (using linen, satin or aida ground fabric)
- 4. Stump Work or 3-Dimentional Embroidery
- 5. Brazilian Embroidery, using Rayon Brazilian Threads
- 6 Any needlework listed above worked by a person over 70 years of age.
