EXPO New Mexico Hosts Super Spooky Halloween Fun for the Kids

*EXPO Offers "Trunk or Treat" Event as a Great Alternative to
Traditional Trick or Treating*

EXPO New Mexico is a great place to be for Halloween, and the list of things to do just got a little "sweeter" with the addition of "Trunk or Treat" for the kiddos on Saturday, October 31, starting at 4:00 PM. Beginning earlier that day at 11:00 AM there will be a Main Street Classic Car show for which participants will later convert their trunks for candy distribution as part of the Main Street trick or treating. The general public is invited to all the day's events.

Car show participants will line up along Main Street to showcase their vehicles and in order to provide the candy and treats. For the second year, the event is being held at EXPO New Mexico, but has a new home within the site at the Beef Barn, providing ample space for an extended and extra scary experience. In addition to the Mile of Terror, the event producers will once again be offering Wicked Zombie Paintball.
