Objectives

- 3. Provide access to quality education by incorporating sustainability and social impact topics in education sessions.
 - a. X% of sessions covered these topics.
- 4. Prioritize circularity targets through responsible production and consumption.
 - a. Reduce 50% of waste by eliminating, redesigning, or renting materials needed.
