USE FEES:

The rings are provided as a set for **\$404.00 a day**. If a set-up with livestock panels is requested, there is a labor charge of **\$100.00 per man-hour set-up and tear-down of the panels**.

If your event will include alcohol to be served or sold, it will be done so exclusively by our Alcohol Services Contractor and security personnel are required to be present. The County will work with you to provide contact information for the Alcohol Services Contractor. Those using the facility for events with alcohol service need to provide hours of operation, number of points of sale desired, etc. **All requests must be in at least 6 weeks prior to the event.** The County will schedule the security personnel for your event with the County's security contractor. The number of security personnel needed is based on how many guests will be attending. The User is responsible for covering the security costs and that expense will be discussed in detail when the Use of the building is arranged. Security costs are \$26.00 per hour, per guard, with a 4-hour Minimum. Holiday rates will be higher and will be quoted at the time your reservation is made.

SPECIFICS OF SPACE:

- The Large Covered Show Ring measures 60 ft. x 120 ft. (7,200 square feet,) is entirely fenced with chain link and gates on the east and west sides, has wood shavings as footing on the surface, lighting, and a sound system.
- The Small Show Ring (or Auction Ring, as some refer to it) is 40 ft. x 60 ft. (2,400 square feet, is not fenced but can be enclosed with livestock panels, has wood shavings as footing on the surface, lighting, and a sound system. Some events choose to use this as a set-up/staging area for participants in the activity happening in the Large Covered Show Ring.

The User must furnish a certificate of liability insurance, with the minimum limits of liability being **\$1,000,000.00 per occurrence** for each bodily injury and property damage, and **\$2,000,000.00 aggregate**. The insurance documents will also include a page serving as the Additional Insured Policy endorsement stating the policy has been altered to include Washington County, Its' elected officials, officers, agents, and employees as additional insured.
